



Year 5/6, 7/8, 9/10 and 11/12's are invited to participate in the... SACSA Esports – Rocket League trial competition!

SACSA has developed an Esports competition. Your school is invited to be a part of the trial before the competition starts in full. with our Year 5/6, 7/8, 9/10 and 11/12's teams can be boys or girls or mixed genders.

Teams need to consist of three students one of which should be designated as Captain. The Captain is responsible for ensuring that all players in the team are logged in and ready for their games. All three players will be required to play at the same time.

This will be a free trial period however, when the competition starts in full it will incur a small entry fee.

The competition will take place from Tuesday 2nd June and will start at 4:30pm.

You must have the Rocket League game, a gaming console (PS4, Nintendo Switch, Xbox One) or you can download it onto a gaming desktop.

To be able to compete in this event you will need to nominate yourself with your team name:

- 1. Go to the SACSA website www.sacsasports.com.au
- 2. Click the Sports drop down and select Esports
- 3. Fill out the required details including the team name you have decided on (it must have your school name included and be appropriate) e.g Tyndale Titans
- 4. Read all the terms and agreement section
- 5. Make sure you fill out all the required details then click agree and submit nomination at the end.

NOMINATIONS MUST BE COMPLETED BY SUNDAY 31st MAY BEFORE 9PM

Once you have submitted your nomination, SACSA will send out further information to you about how to log in etc, then another email will be sent on the day showing time, tournament name and password of the trial competition. You will then be added into the competition to compete against other students from SACSA member schools. This trial competition will initially run for approximately 1 hour each week til the end of term 2, however once finalised it will run for all of term 3.
