The **2020** soccer season is around the corner and West Beach Primary School will be entering teams into the **North West Junior Soccer Association (NWJSA)** competition. The NWJSA is a professionally run association which endeavours to teach children the skills and rules of soccer with the emphasis on **friendship, sportsmanship, healthy living** and **working together as a team**. The competition is open to school boys and girls, 5 years and up; every child is encouraged to participate irrespective of their abilities.

For younger children, this low contact game is a safe, non-competitive interschool competition and a great introduction to team sport. For our more senior grades, soccer skills are developed to compete in one of the best interschool competitions available. The competition runs during school **terms 2 and 3**. All grades get the chance to participate in the 'End of Season' soccer carnival bringing the season to a close in a fun day for all the family.

Each child will be presented with a trophy as a keepsake at a whole school assembly at the end of the season.

Parent Volunteers: Each team requires a

- a **coach** to lead training each week and guide on game days (*must attend Coach's registration morning on 2nd May 2020, further info. to be provided, this is when program is distributed*)
- a **manager** to communicate information within the team and
- a **first aid** person to bring the first aid kit provided to each game.

No experience necessary and roles can be shared. Please consider this carefully as teams **WILL NOT** participate without volunteers for these positions.

Training Clinics: Under 6 & 7 teams are required to attend a coaching clinic held each week by NWJSA for 30 minutes immediately prior to each game.

School Training: To be arranged between coach, team manager and team. This is usually once a week for approximately 45mins. after school.

Uniform: Royal blue shorts, royal blue football socks, football boots, shin guards (**compulsory**). Each player will be issued a playing shirt which **MUST** be returned at the end of season. If top is not returned, player will be invoiced \$30

Registration: All registration forms (page 2) must be returned to the school front office. **No late registrations will be accepted if teams are full. If the late registration is possible, NWJSA charge a \$20 late fee.**

Fees: \$50 per child. Cost covers player registration, player insurance, trophies, use of school playing shirt, training balls etc. Payment can either be paid at school front office or via QKR.
