

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Y11 & 12 – TRANSITION PLANNING



- Career counselling and information (compulsory career interviews for all Y12s)
- College-based and/or offsite VET
 - Support and monitoring for offsite VET
 - University & TISC presentations (Y12)
- Work experience coordination and support (by request)

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SENIOR SCHOOL PATHWAYS

Uni Direct (use ATAR for university entrance)

- Year 11: 6 subjects (min. 5 ATAR)
- Year 12: 5 or 6 subjects (min. 5 ATAR)
- Top 4 subjects will determine student's ATAR
- Aiming for ATAR of 70+

Best pathway for:

- Competitive university courses (limited places)
- University courses with special requirements (e.g. Ag. Science, Med.)
- Entry into university courses in other states and internationally

SENIOR SCHOOL PATHWAYS

Uni Transition (non-ATAR university entrance)

- Year 12: 5 or 6 subjects (max. 2 ATAR) combined with...
- Curtin UniReady OR
- Cert IV Qualification
- Must achieve English competency
- Aiming for **nominal** 70 ATAR

Best pathway for:

- WA University courses with guaranteed entry of 70 ATAR*
- UWA Experience-based entry (Comprehensive degree courses)

COST OF OFF-SITE VET



From 2024, the College will pay **up to \$2000** per annum, per student towards the cost of offsite VET courses. Families must pay costs in excess of \$2000 per annum, per student.

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VET AND UNIVERSITY ENTRANCE



- Cert IV and Diploma qualifications may be used for university entrance
- Cert IV + English competency
 nominal 70 ATAR
- Diploma + English competency = nominal 80 ATAR
- UWA new experience-based entry (Cert IV = 60 points)





CURTIN UNI READY & UNIVERSITY ENTRANCE

- Curtin UniReady enabling program
 - research, academic writing & referencing focus
 - 4 subjects = 4 units
 - offered as a timetabled subject in Y12 only
- Offered 'by invitation' (60-65% average achieved in Year 11 subjects)

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- Also offered post-school as single semester (free)
- 65%+ achievement = entry to UWA comprehensive degrees (except for Bachelor of Philosophy)
