Jane was diagnosed with MND in June 2023. Her particular MND is caused by a hereditary gene mutation, the SOD1 gene which becomes toxic to other nerve cells.

MND took her mother's life in 1990, her cousin's life in 2010 and now she is also facing the same fight.

With the advances in technology there is now a treatment that may slow down the progression of the disease but unfortunately there is no cure.

Every 3 weeks Jane's husband drives her to Sydney for a lumbar puncture under imaging. This treatment is ongoing and currently the only glimmer of hope for her and her family.

All proceeds raised will be put into MND Research, specifically the Macquarie University and Prof Dominic Rowe and his team.

His tireless efforts, enthusiasm, dogged dedication and care for his patients is inspiring and gives Jane and her family hope that one day there will be a MND free future.
