Ronald McDonald House has many volunteers that help run the centre. They clean, look after the families staying there and transport patients to and from the hospital. They have 130 volunteers that do not get paid to work and they have 2 people that work fulltime and are paid a wage. Ronald McDonald House in Orange is a not-for profit organisation that supports people who have family members that are undergoing treatment in the Orange Base Hospital. They help by providing families with a place to stay and necessities to help them through their tough time.



Ronald McDonald House relies on donations from the community. The donations that they receive are many different things such as money, soap, food, blankets, toys and soft toys for the children. Just these little things can make a family's life there so much more comfortable and make them feel like a family and loved by RMDH.

The volunteers work many unpaid hours. Since RMDH opened on the 13th of April 2015 they have worked a total of 71,054 hours. In 2020 they clocked up a massive 10,241.30 hours of voluntary unpaid work.
