## ABOUT THIS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Students selected for this scholarship program will participate in a dedicated 60 minute weekly session as part of a group of 8-10 students from years 4-6. Sessions will run after lunch and will be held at the Buninyong Campus. Transport will be provided for Scotsburn Campus students as required.

This program will be led by Steven Skilbeck, an accomplished musician. This program will revolve around the continuation of our school band. Students will build on their musical skills and apply those skills as part of the band. Once ready, the band will play at assemblies and other events, including the 'Kids Day Out' event in Bacchus Marsh.

Required musical equipment will be provided by the school, but those that would like to bring their own instruments are welcome to do so.

For this scholarship program, we're looking for students with a passion for music who would like to be part of a band. Participation will require a commitment to practising out of school.

## **APPLICATION PROCESS**

Students currently in grades 3, 4 and 5 are now invited to apply for a spot in the 2025 Music Scholarship Program. Students from both campuses are invited to apply, including those that have been part of a scholarship program in 2025. The closing date for applications is Friday November 28.

To apply, students need to write a letter explaining why they would like to participate and why they should be selected. Students are also invited to include extra documents that demonstrate their interest and capabilities related to music and performing.

Whilst students can apply for 2 or more scholarship programs, they can only be selected for 1.
