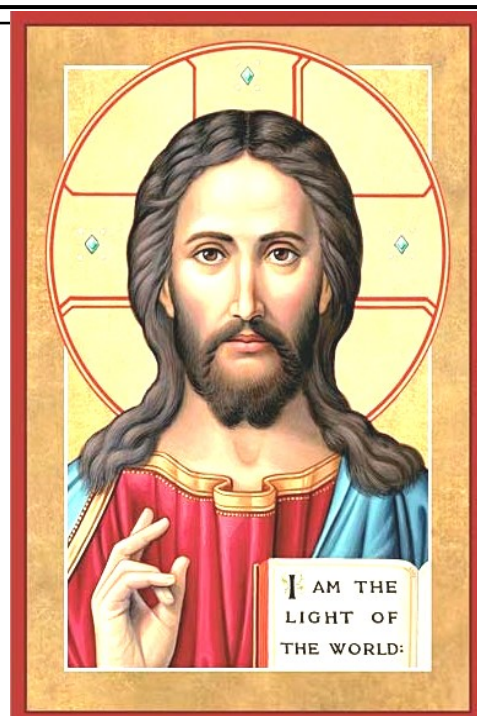

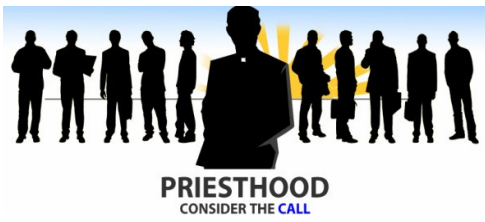
**House to House Family Rosary St Joseph's Bulli**

**We make this prayer with many, through Jesus who gives life to all living things. AMEN**

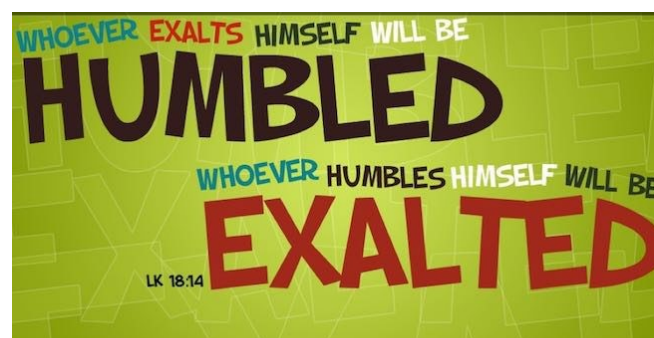


**Responsorial Psalm:** The Lord hears the cry of the poor.

**Gospel Acclamation:** *Alleluia, alleluia! God was in Christ, to reconcile the world to himself; and the Good News of reconciliation he has entrusted to us. Alleluia, alleluia!*

**Gospel Reading:** A reading from the holy Gospel according to Luke

Jesus spoke the following parable to some people who prided themselves on being virtuous and despised everyone else, 'Two men went up to the Temple to pray, one a Pharisee, the other a tax collector. The Pharisee stood there and said this prayer to himself, "I thank you, God, that I am not grasping, unjust, adulterous like the rest of mankind, and particularly that I am not like this tax collector here. I fast twice a week; I pay tithes on all I get." The tax collector stood some distance away, not daring even to raise his eyes to heaven; but he beat his breast and said, "God, be merciful to me, a sinner." This man, I tell you, went home again at rights with God; the other did not. For everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, but the man who humbles himself will be exalted.'



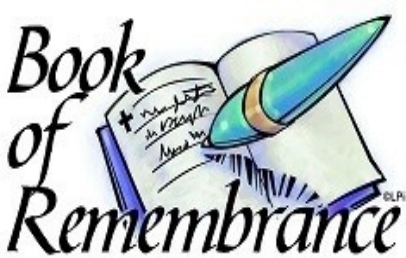
**Communion Antiphon:** *We will ring out our joy at your saving help and exult in the name of our God.*

**Gospel Reflection: *Standing in the Humous of life:*** This week's gospel passage flows on directly from last week's gospel and continues the teachings of Jesus about prayer. Last week's Gospel emphasised the need for **persistence in prayer**, this week's is about the way in which we come **before God in prayer**. It's the tax collector's simple prayer: '**God, be merciful to me, a sinner,**' who goes home at rights with God. This simple prayer recognises that he is **not in right relationship with God and asks for God's mercy**. This is hallmark of the lowly and outcast in the gospel of Luke and the **model of faith** that is depicted over and over again in this gospel is the one who **recognises their need for God's loving mercy and asks for it**. We are repeatedly reminded that **God's mercy, forgiveness and abundant love are constantly out-flowing towards us** and all we have to do is **humbly desire and welcome them. Humility is at the heart of this parable**. The Pharisee represents **those who are assured of their own rightness but who rely on comparison with others** to make themselves feel **righteous and justified**. This Pharisee's attitude of **asserting his own faithfulness and religious observance** by comparison with **others can be easily seen in the world today**. All faiths seem to be afflicted with these characters who assure themselves of their own 'goodness' by railing against those who are different. But, as the parable assures us, **it is the humble who are exalted by God.** ©Michael Tate
