The University Clinical Aptitude Test (<u>UCAT</u>) is a computer-based test that helps universities select applicants with the most appropriate abilities and professional behaviours required for new doctors and dentists to succeed. It is used alongside other admissions processes such as interviews and academic qualifications. It is also an opportunity to stand out from other applicants and demonstrate aptitude for a demanding programme of study.
