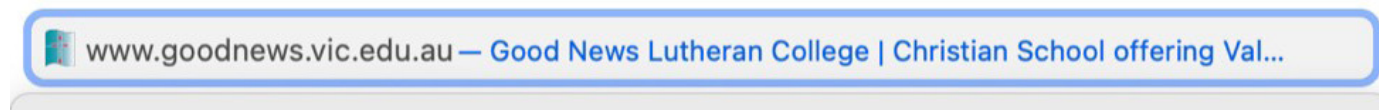

We are excited to provide the following information on how to set up and navigate through the system, as Schoolbox enables you to be partners with us during your child's education at GNLC.

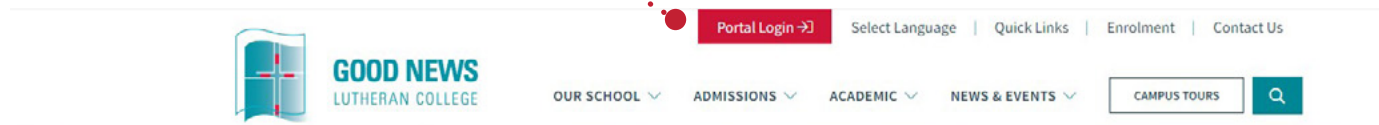

The top menu allows families to access the following information:

HOME:

Returns you back to the home page

GROUPS:

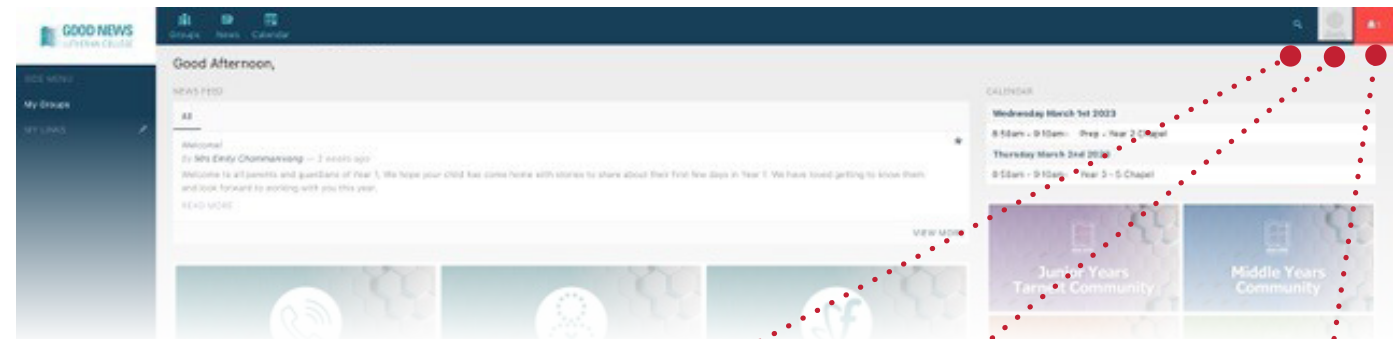
Enables viewing of all the individual groups which are relevant to your family

NEWS:

Displays a list of news items published within the GNLC community

CALENDAR:

A calendar view of your child's timetable and assessments



MAGNIFYING GLASS:

Search for information within the Schoolbox system

USER PROFILE:

Users can personalise settings, log out and view current details we have on file


NOTIFICATIONS BELL:

News Feed

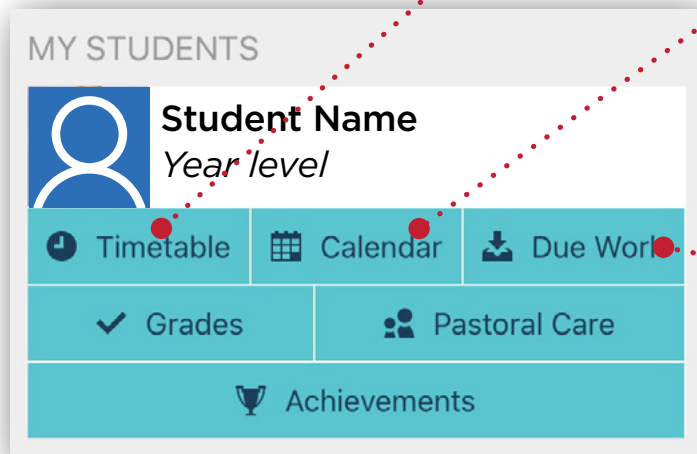

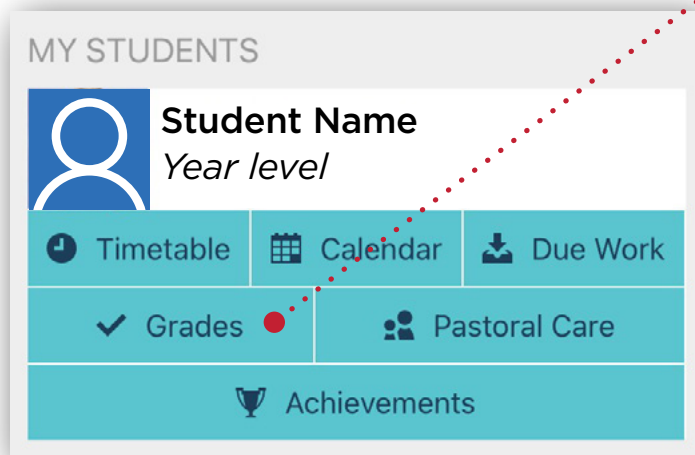
Filters | List | **Month** | Week | Day | Export

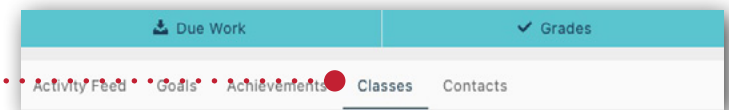
GRADES: Displays all subjects your child is currently studying and associated assessments.

Families are able to **EMAIL THEIR CHILD'S CLASSROOM TEACHER** by following these simple steps below:

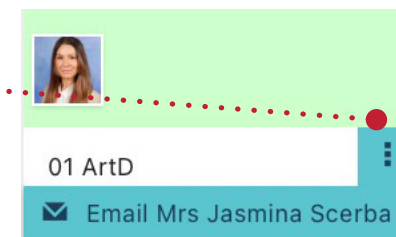
1 Click on your **CHILDS IMAGE**



2 Click on **CLASSES**

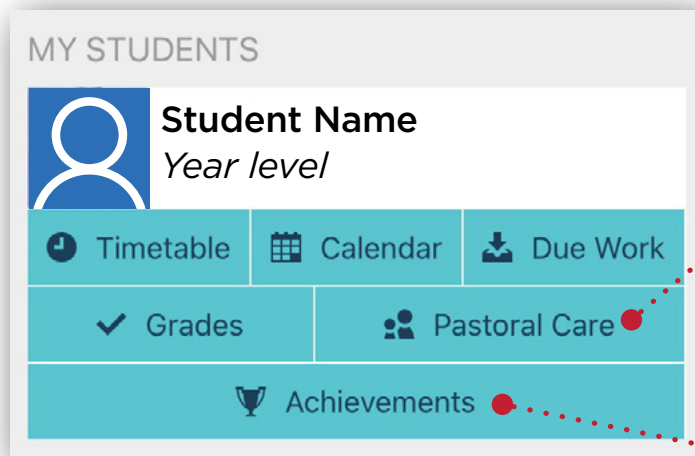


3 Click on the **THREE DOTS** to reveal an envelope that when clicked, will link you directly to a teachers email
