I don't usually track my reading because I don't read nearly as much as I would like to, but I've recently started using Goodreads which is pretty cool.

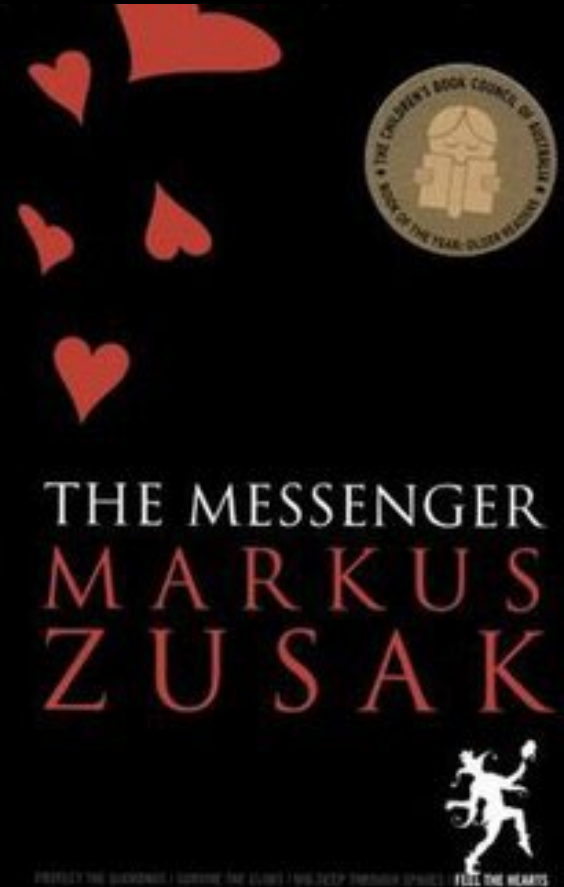





## Recent favorite book
