





## TEMPORARY MASS CHANGES AS A RESULT OF THE INCREASING RISK OF CORONAVIR

- Communion of the Precious Blood will be for celebrant only
- Communion will be received only in the hand
- Clergy and parishioners are not to shake hands during the sign of peace.
- All ministers of Holy Communion( both ordinary & extraordinary) are to use hand sanitisers before the distribution of Holy Communion. They are not to physically touch anyone in the act of blessing.
- Holy water fonts are to be emptied

These are directives from the Australian Government Department of health and they will stay in place until the need for them ceases.

## When we receive the <u>Sacred Host</u> we receive: the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ, Our Lord and Saviour in the Holy Eucharist.




parish. Followed by Morning tea with the parish - All welcome.

# <u>Responsorial Psalm</u>: Lord let you mercy be on us, as we place our trust in you.


<u>Gospel Acclamation:</u> Glory and praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ! From the shining cloud the Father's voice is heard: This is my beloved Son, hear him. Glory and praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ.

#### **<u>Gospel Reading</u>: A reading from the holy Gospel according to Matthew** Jesus took with him Peter and James and his brother John and led them up a high mountain where they could be alone. There in their

presence he was transfigured; his face shone like the sun and his clothes became as white as the light. Suddenly Moses and Elijah appeared to them; they were talking with him. Then Peter spoke to Jesus. 'Lord,' he said 'it is wonderful for us to be here; if you wish, I will make three tents here, one for you, one for Moses and one for Elijah.' He was still speaking when suddenly a bright cloud covered them with shadow, and from the cloud there came a voice which said, 'This is my Son, the Beloved; he enjoys my favour. Listen to him.' When they heard this, the disciples fell on their faces, overcome with fear. But Jesus came up and touched them. 'Stand up,' he said 'do not be afraid.' And when they raised their eyes they saw no one but only Jesus. As they came down from the mountain Jesus gave them this order. 'Tell no one about the vision until the Son of Man has risen from the dead.'

## Sts. Louis and Zelie Martin

Feast Day: July 12,Patronage: Illness, Marriage, Parenting, Widowers.On Sunday, October 18, 2015, Pope Francis presided at Mass in St Peter's Square whichincluded the Rite of Canonization for Sts. Zelie and Louis Martin. The Pope stated in his

homily "The holy spouses Louis Martin and Marie- Azelie Guerin practiced Christian service in the family, <u>creating day by day</u> and <u>environment</u> of <u>faith</u> and <u>love which nurtured the vocations of</u> <u>their daughters</u>, among whom was <u>Saint Therese</u> of the Child Jesus". They are the first ever married couple with children to be canonized in the same ceremony. <u>Louis Martin</u>(1823-1894) was a watchmaker by trade, and quite a successful one. He also skilfully managed his wife's lace business. <u>Zelie Guerin</u>(1831- 1877) was one of Alecon's more talented lace makers. Born into a military family, Zelie described her childhood and youth as "dismal". Her mother and father showed her little affection.
