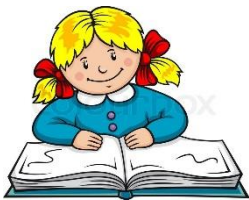

10. On the shelves at the supermarket were 2 sizes of dishwashing liquid. One bottle held 450 millilitres, while a larger one held 1 litre. What is the **DIFFERENCE** in volume of detergent contained in these two containers?
