Dear Parents and Carers,

Hope all families have started settling back into some normality. It is so great to see how happy both Teachers and Children are to be back this Term.

This letter is to inform you of the School Fees and Levies for the 2021 school year. 2020 has been a challenging year for our community. We thank families for continuing to pay fees and levies throughout 2020.

2020 Levies Re-credited

Whilst costs reduced in some areas, the school faced increased costs in technology infrastructure, equipment and resources, and increased cleaning costs. The school's fundraising capacity also reduced significantly this year as expected. The school has analysed the costs incurred in all areas and have made a decision to re-credit the following 2020 Levies to parents via a credit to their existing Fee account with St James Primary for unspent portions of 2020 Levies charged/paid as follows :

- Grade 3 Camp Levies - \$185 per student
- Grade 4 Camp Levies - \$315 per student
- Total other Levies Re-credited/refunded:
 - Prep to Grade 2 \$160 per student
 - Grade 3 to Grade 4 \$190 per student
 - Grade 5 to Grade 6 \$240 per student (includes Interschool Sports)

The total credit will appear on your next fee statement. For families who have fully paid their fees a credit will appear as a prepayment on your fee account to be offset against the following year's fees. Those families who are leaving the school at the close of the school year and have fully paid their account will be refunded their respective credit.

We have a small number of parents who have indicated that their re-credit be donated to the school. If you would like to make this generous donation please send an email to the Principal advising same and we thank you for your generosity.

2021 School Fees

The School in conjunction with the School Advisory Board and CEM Business Manager are always conscious to ensuring that Catholic Education is affordable for all families and any fee increases are minimal.

The CEM Business Manager in consultation with the School Advisory Council has ratified the following School Fees for the 2021 school year:

- There will be no increase to the Capital levy per family.
- The total school fees will only increase by 1.9% in line with educational CPI and as recommended by Catholic Education guidelines. This equates to \$68 for the family fee for the year and \$16 to \$29 per year for levies depending on the year level.
