EVENT DEFINITIONS

“TWO PHASE” ARTICLE 274 (5.3) A competition comprising two phases run without interruption. The finishing line for the first phase is the starting line for the second phase. There will be eight or nine fences in the first phase, and four, five or six fences in the second phase including one combination. Competitors incurring a penalty in the first phase, or exceeding the time allowed, will be halted by the bell after completing the first phase. Competitors will be placed according to penalties and time in the second phase and, if necessary, to their penalties and time in the first phase.

“GRAND PRIX” ARTICLE 261 (5.2) This competition is designed to encourage better jumping by making performance over obstacles the principal factor. The competition consists of two rounds, plus a Jump-Off for a limited number of riders.

ROUND 1 All riders take part in Round One with ten, eleven or twelve obstacles, including at least one combination. The “Time Allowed” is calculated using a speed of 275m/min for “Freshman”, 275m/min for “Encourage, 300 m/min for “Improvers”, “Progressive” and “Intermediates” and 325 m/min for “Advanced” & “Stars”. Time penalties apply if the “Time Allowed” is exceeded (1 penalty per four seconds or part thereof). The “Time Limit” is twice the “Time Allowed”. Any rider exceeding the “Time Limit” is eliminated.

ROUND 2 All riders, including those who were eliminated or who retired during Round One, may take part in Round Two. Riders ride the same course with the same obstacles (excepting that the number of obstacles in Round Two may be reduced to a minimum of eight) in the same draw order as for Round One, excepting that all obstacles in Round Two are raised 5cm. Time penalties again apply.

JUMP-OFF All riders who have ridden two clear rounds take part in the Jump-Off, plus all others with the least number of penalties so that at least 25% of the field participate. The Jump-Off will consist of a minimum of six obstacles, including a combination. All obstacles in the Jump-Off are raised a further 5cm. Riders in the Jump-Off, ride in reverse order to their aggregate penalties and, if on equal penalties, to their time incurred in Round Two.

PLACINGS Riders who take part in the Jump-Off, are placed according to their aggregate penalties, including their penalties in Round One and Round Two which are carried forward into the Jump-Off, and, if on equal penalties, to their time incurred in the Jump-Off. The remaining riders are placed according to their aggregate penalties in Round One and Round Two and, if on equal penalties, to their time incurred in Round Two.

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS – PLEASE READ

- All participants in an Open Competition, Clinic or activity - including Pony Club Members- MUST sign a Public Liability Declaration Form.
- Riders without adequate Insurance Liability Cover MUST ALSO complete the Day Participant Waiver and pay \$10 per day fee.
- Participants who are NOT current members of PCAV, HRCav, Equestrian Australia* (EA), an Inter State Pony Club, Arab Horse Society of Australia (AHSA), Australian Endurance Riders Association (AERA) and cannot provide proof that they are covered by Public Liability Insurance Policy with a minimum of \$10,000,000.00 cover must pay \$10 per day to cover the cost to participate at this event.
- Participants must provide proof of current membership or Insurance cover to avoid paying the \$10 per day Day Participant Fee (*EA -must be a direct member, not just a member of an EA affiliated Club)
- Protection is afforded to the Day Participant under the PCAV Public Liability policy, only whilst participating in activities organized and/or run by the PCAV club at that event, where they are liable for causing bodily injury or property damage to others, excluding whilst travelling to and from such event. By completing the Day Participant Waiver form, you agree to abide by the Rules and Conditions of the PCAV and any Rules of the Event.
- The PCAV insurance policy specifically states that anyone not following PCAV rules may be left uninsured. Proof of P.C.A.V, HRCav, EA, AHSA, AERA membership cards must be presented to the Secretary's office before the competition commences.

Awards:

Placings will be allocated to 6th place in each section.

An overall Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded for each level. Championships will be decided on the best average placing over both classes. Equal placings will be split on the best time. A further award will be given to the winning schools team challenge.

Schools Team JUMP Challenge: The best 3 combination performances in the Championships from each school will be used to decide the winning school team challenge. An award will be awarded to the winning school and sashes awarded to 3rd place for school team places.

Attire:

- White or Light coloured jodhpurs & school sports uniform that may include school jumper, shirt & tie or polo top
- No riding jackets.
- Medical armbands are compulsory
- Current Pony Club Victoria standard helmets must be worn, as per P.C.A.V rules. Spot checks of helmets may occur.
- Numbers: Bridle or saddle blanket numbers on both sides of the horse (supplied by the rider) or body numbers supplied by Macarthur Pony Club.
- No Plaiting.

General:

- All riders must represent the school of their current enrolment.
- Each school must nominate a team manager on the entry form and to be present at the competition. Team managers are responsible for gear checking the riders in their team and ensure they comply with the rules. If in doubt about gear please ask. Riders and manager must check into Office
- Riding of bareback, rugged, or unbridled horses is prohibited.
- All entries are accepted at the discretion of Macarthur Pony Club Inc and they reserve the right to alter the program as they deem necessary. The judge's decision will be final.
- Please notify all scratchings to macarthurpc@hotmail.com as soon as possible.
- Presentations will be conducted as soon as possible; prize winners should be dressed in school riding uniform at the presentation.
- No refund of entry fee after closing date.
- Refunds prior to entry closing date will incur a \$10.00 administration fee
