## 9 QUEST Orienteering Activity: Friday 12 February 2021

Dear 9 QUEST Parents and Guardians,

As part of the 9 QUEST Program in Term 1, we will be heading off-campus this Friday 12 February to Waterworks Reserve in South Hobart to complete a set of Orienteering courses.

Students will be in small groups and will use a map and compass to navigate along a permanent orienteering course set up by Orienteering Tasmania. There are three courses: short, medium and long. Students may choose their level of challenge and may have time to complete more than one course during the day.

There are free barbeques at Waterworks Reserve and students are welcome to bring something appropriate to cook for lunch. There are toilet and drinking facilities at the Reserve.

Please note: students should bring all of the following equipment, regardless of forecast weather.

- PE uniform including pair of joggers with good grip
- Morning tea & lunch
- Day pack (school backpack okay)
- At least 1 litre of drinking water
- A sunhat & sunscreen
- A waterproof rain jacket
- A warm fleece long-sleeve top / jacket
- Personal medications required to self-manage in a non-urban setting

The staff group will carry first-aid kits and mobile phones. The group will be accompanied and supervised by Mrs Desiréé Smuts, Mr Ben Jarvis, and Mr David Witcomb. Mr Witcomb and Mr Jarvis, both experienced bus drivers, will transport the student and staff group in two College buses and/or Wisby buses.

Students will leave Southern Christian College at 9:30am after Pastoral Care on Friday 12 Februaryand return to College at approximately 3:00pm.
