Dear Parents, Carers and Students,

**Our final Progress Checks will be released to families after 3:30 pm on Wednesday 28 October.**

What an extraordinary year it has been! Onsite, we have seen students excited to be back and learning in the classroom with their peers and being taught face to face which is terrific and we very much look forward to seeing all students back onsite from Monday 26 October.

As we now progress through our final weeks of this academic year, we believe it purposeful to give you a final check on how students are progressing. The focus of this progress check are two-fold. We want to relay to families:

- How students are progressing during this period of learning, be it remote or onsite,
- Indicate if students are on track with their attendance or not, and
- Identify students who are at risk of unsatisfactorily completing the semester of work.

The **rubric** used to assess students with their **behaviour** is as follows:

	Behaviour
Excellent	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Always follows instructions</li> <li>• Always has a respectful and positive attitude</li> <li>• Always follows class code of cooperation</li> <li>• Has a positive impact on the learning of others</li> </ul>
Very Good	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Always follows instructions</li> <li>• Always has a respectful and positive attitude</li> <li>• Always follows class code of cooperation</li> <li>• Does not negatively impact on the learning of others</li> </ul>
Good	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Mostly follows instructions</li> <li>• Mostly has a respectful and positive attitude</li> <li>• Sometimes needs to be reminded about class code of cooperation</li> <li>• Rarely impacts the learning of others in a negative way</li> </ul>
Needs Attention	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Needs to improve his/her ability to listen attentively and follow instructions</li> <li>• Needs to develop a more positive and respectful attitude towards the teacher and fellow students</li> <li>• Needs to avoid any behaviour that negatively impacts the learning of others</li> </ul>

For **attendance**, teachers will provide feedback regarding **all of Semester 2 so far** (Monday 22 June – Friday 16 October) and will indicate if they are on track or not.

Rating	Attendance
On track	90 – 100 %
Needs Attention	< 90 %

Teachers have used the following options when identifying **students who are at risk of unsatisfactorily completing this semester** of work:

At Risk	Reason
No	On track at this stage noting there are assessment tasks scheduled later this semester
Yes	There are a number of assessment tasks that are currently overdue
Yes	Significantly underachieving (not working to their potential)
Yes	Low/Very Low on Senior School Assessment Scale

To access Progress Check results, log into your Compass Portal and you will see the link from your dashboard. If you want to use your mobile app, you will need to open the **web browser**.

To access these results via the browser:

- From the Home Screen, click on the 'View Academic Reports' item
- A list of Academic Reports will be displayed
- Select **2020 Progress Check 6** from the drop down Cycle box at the bottom of the Progress Reports section.
