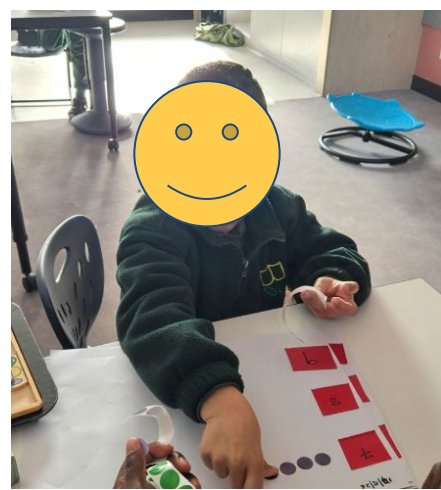
TEACHER MESSAGE
