



Our Preps this term are exploring the famous work Sunflowers by Vincent Van Gogh. Using acrylic paints, students are learning about warm colour palettes, brush control, and texture. We're also taking the time to appreciate Van Gogh's expressive style and unique use of colour and movement.

Grade One and Two

The Grade 1 and 2 students are creating a still life of a fruit bowl. using oil pastels as our meduim. This project encourages them to explore blending techniques, colour harmony, and the balance of composition. We've been focusing on how to look closely at shapes and shadows while adding our own artistic flair.

Grade 3/4

The Grade 3 and 4 students are crafting self-portraits entirely from recycled cardboard and packaging collected from our art room deliveries. This project celebrates individuality and innovation, encouraging students to think outside the box (literally!) and use texture, layering, and shape in imaginative ways.

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## Grade Five and Six

The Grade 5 students are designing the information pack bags that will be given to the incoming kinder kids on their transition day later in the year.

Grade 6 students are creating a mural for their graduation. They will produce a life size self portrait collage which will be on show at their graduation ceremony and the last day of school.
