Create a song to help you practise a set of multiplication facts. Eg. The 3 times tables.	Draw and describe the main character in a book you are reading.	Set the table ready for the next family meal. What crockery and cutler will you need? Where should they be placed?
Explain five situations in everyday life where fractions are used. Draw a picture to represent each. Eg. Cutting a sandwich in half or quarters.	Write the definitions of 10 unusual or unknown words found in a book you are reading.	Find a video tutorial and practise some mindfulness or yoga.
Research an Olympic event and explain all the ways that maths is used within that sport.	Write a procedural text about how to make your favourite meal.	Do the dishes – this could be loading the dishwasher or scrubbing the dishes in the sink.
Choose a number between 1,000 and 10,000. Used words and diagrams to create a poster to show as much information about the number as possible.	Call a relative or friend and talk to them about their day.	Ask a family member for a job you could do for them. Jobs could be, for example: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Was the car- Tidy the lounge room- Organise a cupboard
