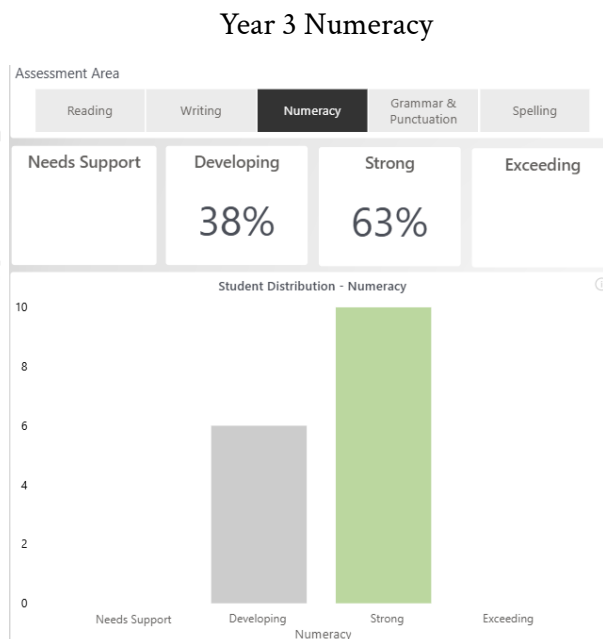
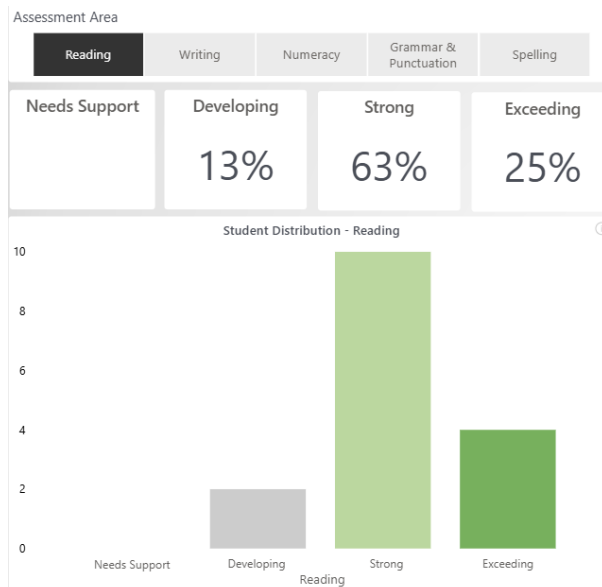

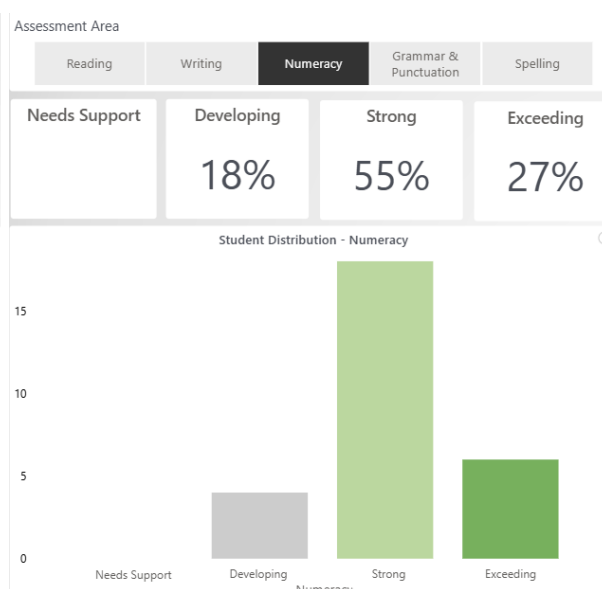
- NAPLAN reports went home to parents last week and teachers have been using this data to inform next steps for students.
