



Interschool Chess Tournaments are a fantastic opportunity for some of our talented students to further challenge and extend themselves in their analytical thinking and problem solving. They serve as a wonderful platform for resilience building in a competitive environment, as well as offer a great opportunity for socialising among peers with similar interests and talents in the wider community.

If your child is enrolled in lunchtime chess classes offered at Rangeview, plays for a chess club, has had chess lessons in the past, or just feels confident enough to attend a chess tournament, please do not hesitate to get in touch! There is no limit to the number of students who can attend a tournament. Only the top four players' scores count towards the team total – so the larger our Rangeview team, the less pressure on the individual players to perform.

The format of the tournament is Individual-based (Swiss pairing method). Each student plays seven games against players of similar skill, regardless of how many games they win or lose. Students experience proper tournament conditions and an opportunity to qualify at the official Victorian State Final Series, which are conducted by Chess Victoria in Term 4.

Rangeview has been invited to take part in the following Chess Victoria Primary Open Zonal in Term 1. If you are interested in taking part, please return this form to the Rangeview Office ASAP so that we can register a place for your child at the tournament. The fee of \$20 per player is to be paid at the tournament (not the Rangeview Office) in a named envelope.
