# **Immunisation**

#### Is your child up to date with their Year 7 and 10 Immunisations?

Several children who were in Year 7 and 10 during 2020 and 2021 have missed out on important <u>High School vaccinations</u> at school.

### What immunisations should my child have had?

If your child has completed Year 7 they should have received these vaccines:

- Human Papillomavirus (HPV) x 2 doses
- <u>Diphtheria</u>, <u>Tetanus</u>, <u>Pertussis</u> (DTP) x 1 dose

If your child has completed Year 10 they should have received these vaccines:

• Meningococcal (Men ACWY)

### How do I check what immunisations my child has had?

You can check by logging into your child's Medicare account through MyGov if your child is under 14 years old.

Due to privacy laws if your child is 14 years or older, they must request for their own immunisation statement.

They can do this:

- Online, by setting up their own <u>myGov</u> account and then accessing their <u>Medicare online</u> account
- Through the Express Plus Medicare mobile app
- Calling the <u>AIR enquiries line</u>. It can take up to 10 business days to get your statement in the post





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### What will this look like on AIR?

If your child has completed the Year 7 or Year 10 immunisation schedule you will see the following immunisations listed (among others).

### Example (Year 7):

27 Feb 2020	Diphtheria Tetanus Pertussis
	Human Papillomavirus
05 Nov 2020	Human Papillomavirus

### Example (Year 10):

30 Mar 2022	Meningococcal ACWY	
OU MAI ZUZZ	Meningecocca / CVV	

If the vaccines are not listed, your child has not completed the Year 7 or Year 10 vaccines.

### What do I do if my child has not had these vaccinations?

You can get these vaccinations done by

- Booking a session with Manningham Council
- Your local Council
- Your GP
