

INFORMATION & TECHNOLOGY 'GETTING STARTED AND CONNECTED – at School'

STEP 1

- a) Log on to a WA College of Agriculture Computer using the following:

Username: firstname.surname

Password: #WACAHarvey2021

(Note: If there are multiple students with the same first name and surname a number will be added after the surname. You will be notified if this is the situation.)

STEP 2

Access 'Connect'

- b) Using an internet browser (Google Chrome, Mozilla, Fire Fox, Edge, etc.) navigate your way to the 'Connect' site using the following address:

- c) Log in using the following:

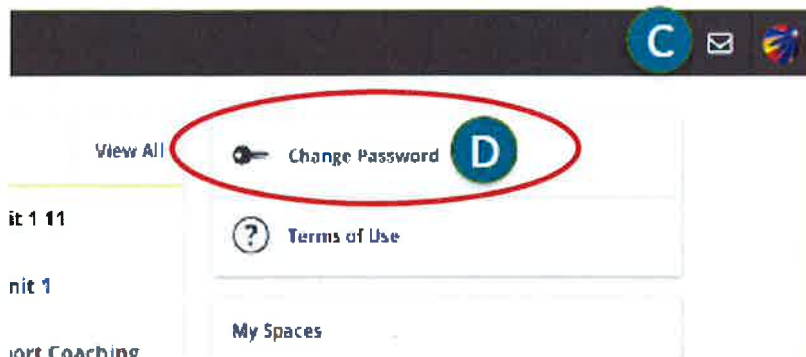

STEP 3

Change your Password

- a) In the top right quarter of your screen you will see 'Change Password'



- b) 'Click' on this and follow the instructions and prompts and change your password to comply with the following parameters:

Your new password must meet the following requirements:

- Must contain at least 10 characters
- Must meet at least 3 of the following character group requirements:
- Must contain at least 1 uppercase letter
- Must contain at least 1 lowercase letter
- Must contain at least 1 digit
- Must contain at least 1 special character
- Must not contain your username
- Must not repeat any of your previous 10 passwords

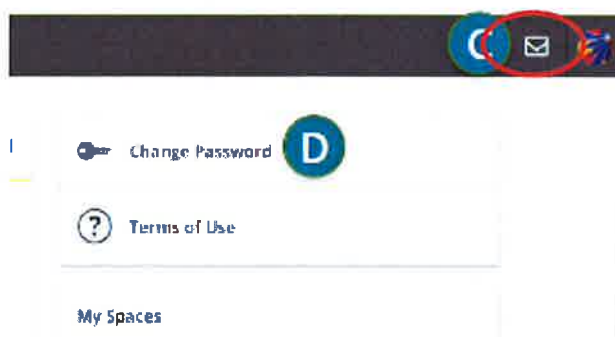
IMPORTANT – do not share or allow other students to use your log on credentials.

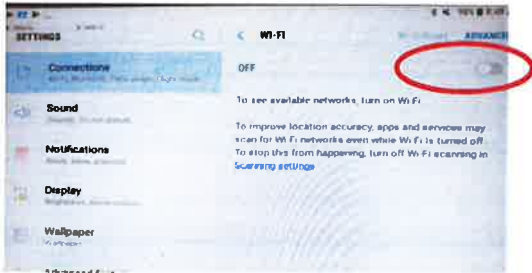

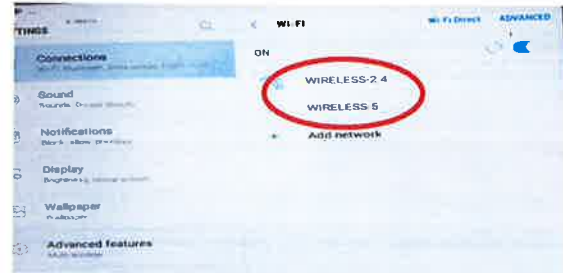
Setting Up Wireless Connectivity on a Device.

The Illustration's in this procedure are on an Android Device but the steps are similar on any device.

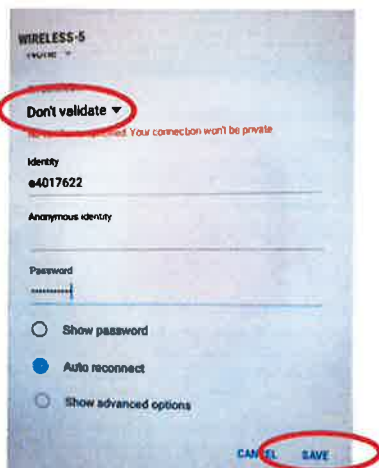
1. Open settings and go to wireless or connections and turn on wireless.



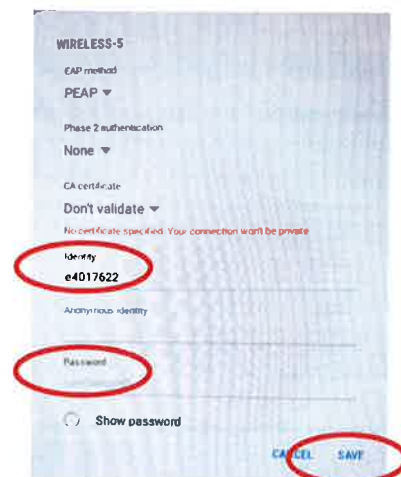
2. Choose either WIRELESS-5 or WIRELESS-2-4 (wireless-5 is faster, wireless 2-4 has more range.)
Select the preferred wireless network.



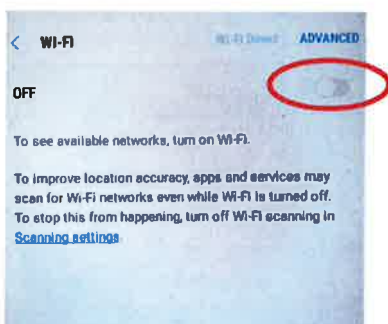
3. On Android devices select 'don't validate' (if you have validate selected you will not be able to save settings)
Select Save



4. Enter your school logon into the username/identity field and enter your password for your school logon into the password field
(User Name/Identity: **joe.smith**
Password: **Xxxxxxxx1** and Save.



5. Sometimes it will not connect the first time. Turn the wireless off



6. Then turn it on again.
