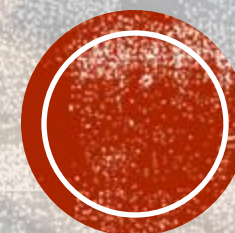

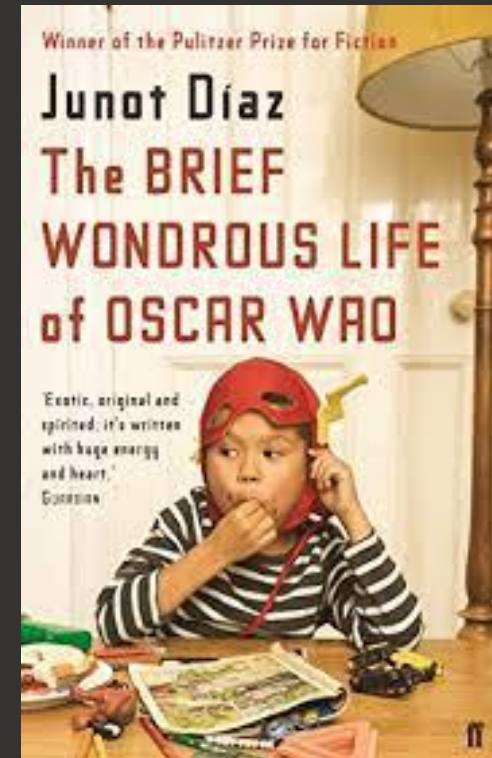
DO YOU TRACK YOUR READING?

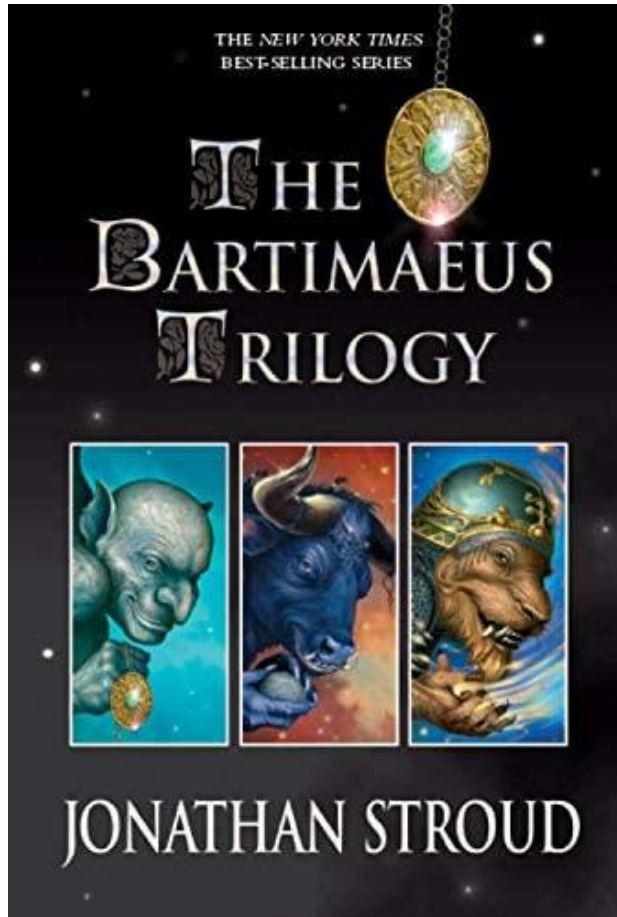
I only track my reading in the sense that I have my bookshelf ordered chronologically from when the books were bought, and I read my way through the bookshelf.
