The Broken Hill Fire and Rescue NSW Station 238 will be coming to school to visit Kindergarten students on Wednesday 1st April, 2020.

During the visit, Fire Station Officers will show students various pieces of equipment, the fire truck, speak to them about how to stay safe around a fire and respond to an emergency situation. This visit will also allow students to ask any questions about fires and how to call 000.

This visit will relate to Personal Developmental, Health and Physical Education outcomes:

PDe-1: Identifies people and demonstrates proactive strategies that help keep themselves, healthy, resilient and safe.

PDe-9: Practises self-management skills in familiar and unfamiliar scenarios (e.g.- how to identify a fire and move away safely).

PDe-10: Uses interpersonal skills to interact effectively with others (e.g.- calling 000, telling an adult).
