1. The first docket shows a customer that collects points for themselves and shows the points available for them to use at Fairleys.
2. The second Docket is where a customer donates 100% of their points to one or more community groups and therefore no points are registered on their docket as they go direct to the nominated group/s.
3. The third docket is a customer that shares points with a community group and keeps some for themselves. (In this example 50% (9) of their points from that transaction are shared with a community group)
4. The fourth docket is where the customer donated 100% of their points and still shows a points total. If this is your docket please use the pledge form below to donate these points that are stuck in your account.

Another note is to check all the dockets from your group account purchases to ensure the points from these purchases are being donated.
