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Uniform Policy

Rationale

Uniform is an important aspect of this school in that it assists in the development of a sense of community. It is therefore expected that all parents who enrol their child / children at St Paul agree to the uniform requirements as specified.

Expectations

The children of St Paul Lutheran School are expected to wear correct school uniform at all times and at official school functions. If, for some reason, this is not possible on a particular occasion, parents are asked to send a note of explanation to the school, directed to the classroom teacher.

Uniform Shop

The Uniform Shop is open during school terms with times advertised on the door and through Inspire (the school newsletter). It stocks all items that form the school uniform and aims to keep prices as affordable as possible. Orders from the uniform shop can also be made through the school office.

St Paul Uniform

Polo Shirt	School-issue with embroidered school logo.
Rugby Shorts or Track Pants	Navy branded school-issue.
Fleece Jumper	School-issue maroon and blue stripe with embroidered school logo.
Socks	White branded school-issue. Other ankle-length style of socks are acceptable for children who prefer a thinner style of sock.
Sports Shoes	Appropriate sports shoes for sports activities. No skate shoes, shoes with studs, or shoes with flashing lights.
Hat	School-issue maroon bucket with printed school logo.

Top	As supplied by the school.
Shorts/Skirt	Skirt supplied by the school or navy shorts.
Socks	White branded school-issue.

Basketball Uniform

Top	As supplied by the school.
Shorts	As supplied by the school.
Socks	White branded school-issue.

For additional sports offered by St Paul Lutheran School- such as Dance, Football and Soccer- the school issued uniform is to be worn.

Additional Information

Rain Jackets

Children are permitted to wear a plain maroon or navy rain jacket.

School Hats

During the months September to April, children are required to wear their appropriately-styled school-issue hat whenever involved in school activities held outside. Children not wearing a hat on at these times will be asked to move to a shaded area of the school.

Winter Scarves

For reasons of safety, winter scarves are not permitted.

Hair

Children are expected to have neatly groomed hair. If long, it is expected that the hair be kept off the face using plain white, navy or maroon hair ties, clips, combs, bands or scrunchies.

Smocks

Smocks are recommended for use during art lessons.

Jewellery

Children may wear a wristwatch that does not have wifi connection

Children may wear no more than one pair of plain gold or silver studs or sleepers. Plain crosses that sit flat to the lobe are also acceptable. No more than one earring in each ear lobe is permitted.

A Medic Alert bracelet may be worn.

Makeup and Nail Polish

Makeup is not permitted. However, the wearing of lip balm (*not* lip gloss) is permitted. Children are not permitted to wear nail polish.

Sunglasses

Children may wear dark framed Cancer Council approved sunglasses for additional eye protection whilst outdoors.

Cultural/Religious Significance

Other items that have cultural or religious significance are permitted, providing they are not deemed to be a safety risk. Please speak with the teacher to have this approved or should you have any questions. The teacher may seek advice from the Principal.
