

WHAT ARE THE ROOMS LIKE?

Rooms vary in size and location across the College. All residents have heated, fully furnished, single rooms with a shared bathroom. Rooms are cleaned weekly and communal spaces, including bathrooms, daily. Graduates have the opportunity to live in share houses on Swanston Street opposite the College, most of which are air-conditioned.

CAN I STAY IN THE MID-YEAR BREAK?

Yes! Our fees cover undergraduates from the beginning of the academic year in February through to final exams in November. Graduates are able to reside at the College for the full calendar year. There are opportunities for summer residency for academic purposes.

IS THERE OPPORTUNITY FOR PART-TIME WORK?

Absolutely. We employ a number of students in our Kitchen, Dining Hall and Academic Centre. In addition, we have Tutor employment opportunities for our graduate and postgraduate residents.

WHAT FINANCIAL AID IS THERE?

In addition to a very generous fee structure, we distribute over \$1,000,000 in scholarships and bursaries to around 70% of our residents, which are paid via a reduction of fees. Scholarships are based upon academic results and do not require an application, whereas bursaries are awarded based on personal circumstance and require a letter of application. All graduates receive a guaranteed Rector's Exhibition (scholarship) of \$3,000.

CAN I MAKE PAYMENTS IN INSTALMENTS?

Yes, we allow for payments to be made in instalments and do not charge you extra to do so.

HOW'S THE FOOD?

We think it's great! We cater for most dietary requirements and serve three daily meals, including hot lunch every day. The kitchen is open all year round, only closing over Easter and Christmas break.
