If you've already applied, log in to your application, browse the full list of courses, and review and update your existing course preferences.

- 19 September School Recommendation Scheme closes
- 30 September Early Bird UAC applications close and processing charges increase after this date
- 22 November- Educational Access Scheme application deadline to get their eligibility letter before December 2021
- 17 December ATAR released

Join us for an online E12 Early Offer and Scholarship Information Webinar to learn about the scheme, eligibility and how to apply. You can also get help with your application, including responding to the three personal statement questions required in your E12 application. The E12 Early Offer and Scholarship Scheme is for students whose parent are receiving a **Family Tax Benefit Part A** on behalf of the Year 12 student. It makes your pathway to the University of Sydney easier and helps reduce the financial pressure of your first-year studies. This year, over 90 courses are offered via E12, and hundreds of students enter the University of Sydney through this scheme each year.

Eligible applicants who meet all the scheme requirements receive:

- a \$5,950 first-year scholarship,

An Australian Apprenticeship (commonly known as an apprenticeship or traineeship) combines paid on-thejob training with formal study resulting in a nationally-recognised qualification. There are more than <u>500</u> <u>occupations</u> across Australia that offer apprenticeships and traineeships, ranging from Certificate II to Advanced Diploma levels, including traditional trades, as well as a number of emerging occupations in most sectors of business and industry.

The Australian Government even provides funding to eligible Australian Apprentices aimed to assist with the costs incurred whist they are undertaking training!
