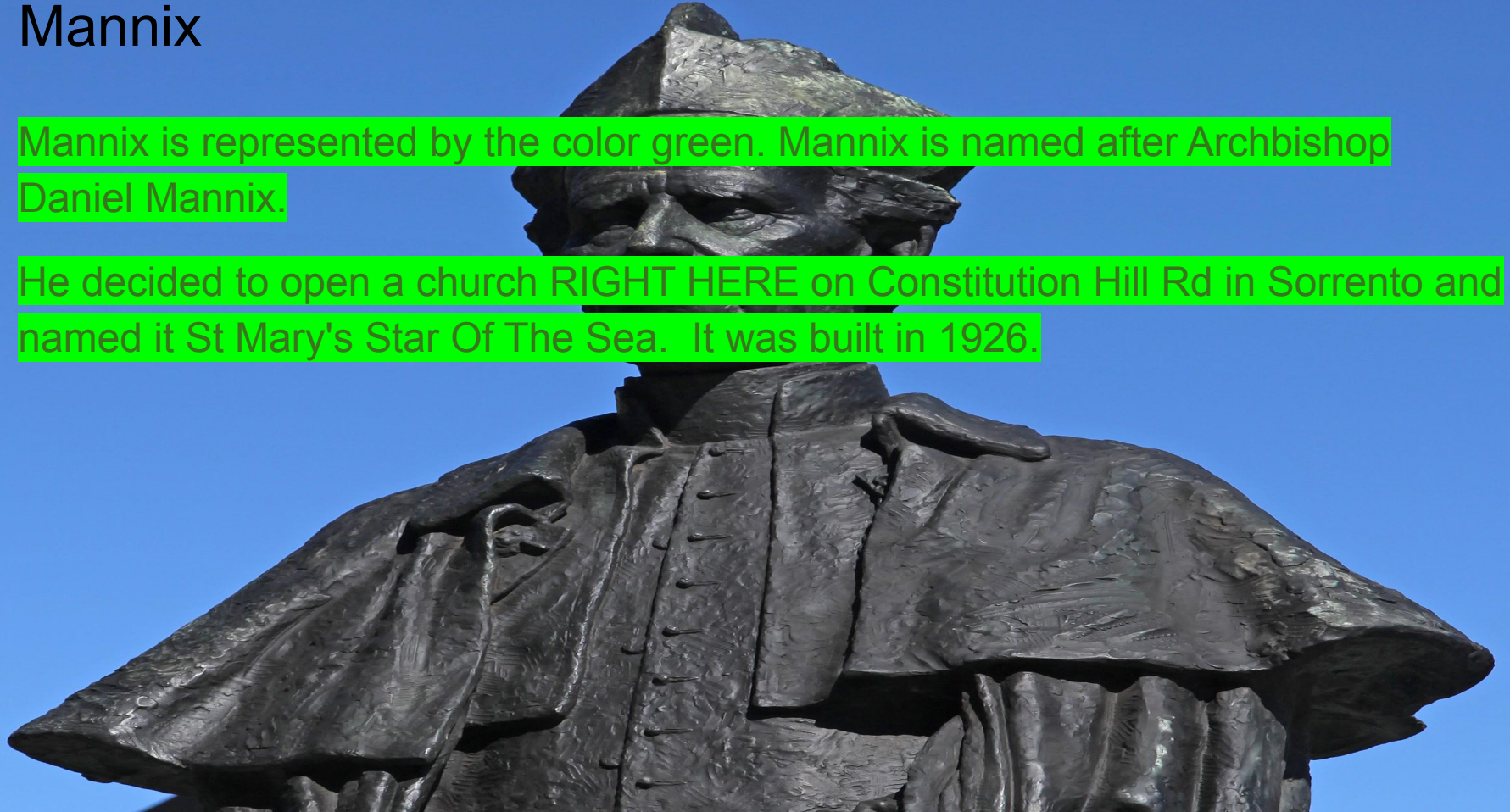

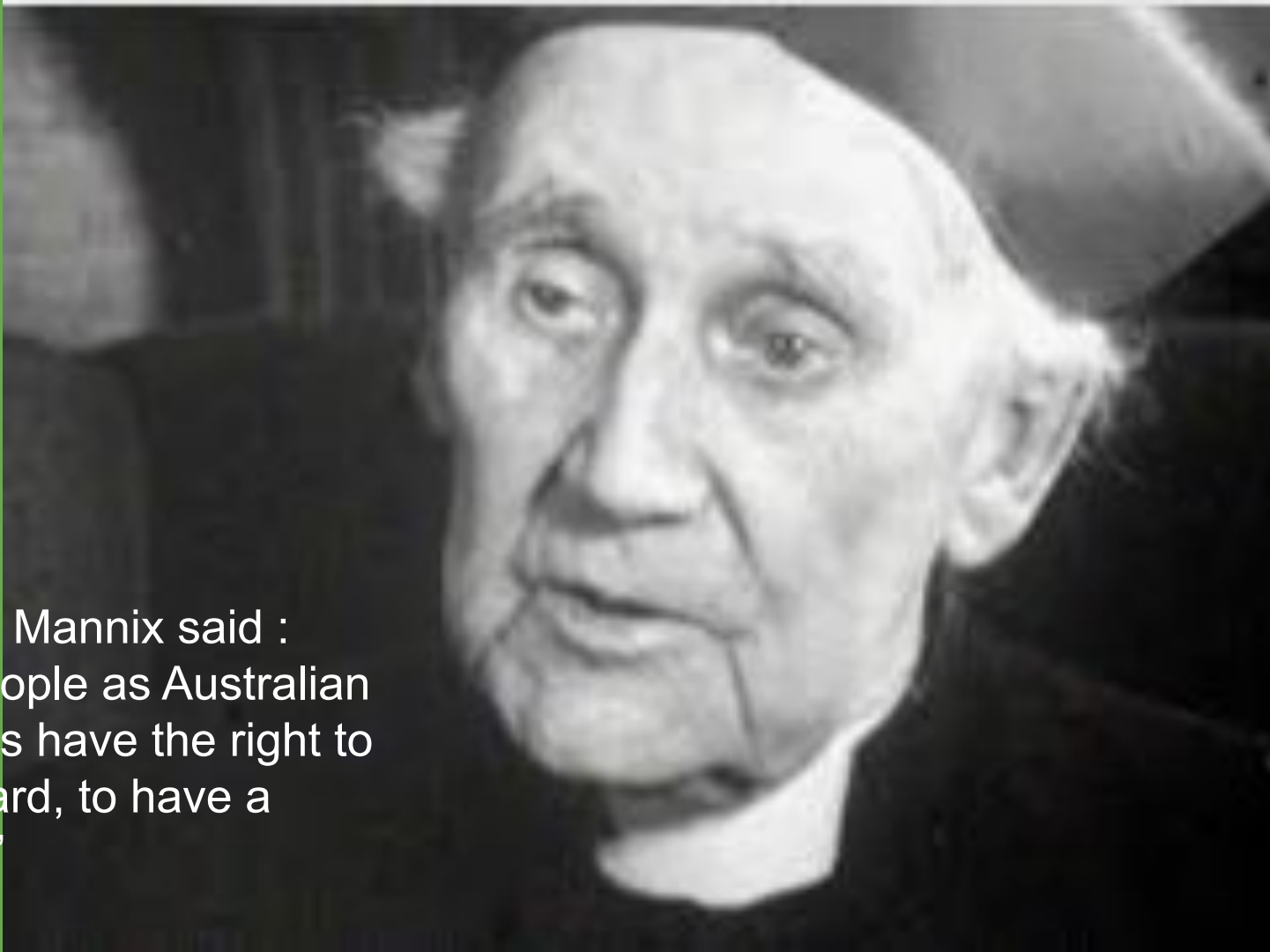


Mannix

Mannix is represented by the color green. Mannix is named after Archbishop Daniel Mannix.

He decided to open a church RIGHT HERE on Constitution Hill Rd in Sorrento and named it St Mary's Star Of The Sea. It was built in 1926.

St Mary's Star of the Sea Parish - first built in 1926

Daniel Mannix was an archbishop who spoke out against conscription during WWI where people were being forced to fight in the wars overseas against their will.

He believed people should be allowed to choose whether they wanted to fight for their country or not.

He also spoke up against the White Australia Policy, believing that all races of people living in Australia had much to offer Australian society and should be allowed to practice their own cultural and religious traditions.



Thomas Hayes

Each year we have an award at the end of the year named after Thomas Hayes. He was the first Parish Priest of our church here, who was given the job by Archbishop Daniel Mannix.

Fr Thomas Hayes used to drive the first school bus to collect the students to come to St Joseph's, even as far as Red Hill. He was very kind and wanted to help all students to be able to come to our school if they wanted to.

The Award is known as the Thomas Hayes Award and is given to a Year 6 Student at the Graduation Mass at the end of the year. It's one of the most important awards and it is given to someone who is a person for others, someone who is kind and caring and represents our school well.



Daniel Mannix chose to place our church in this location in 1926.

Our current catholic church as we see it today was **rebuilt** in 1963.

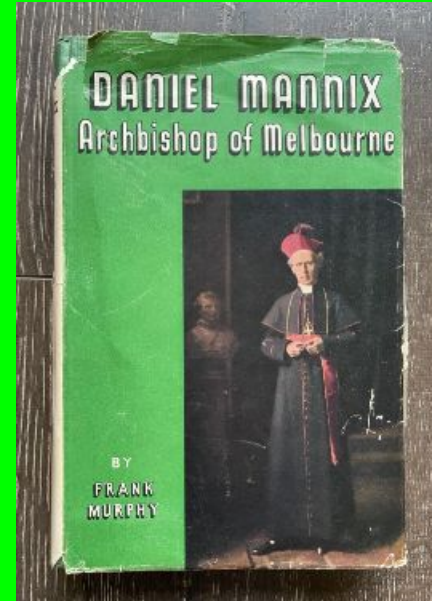
