Reading and Viewing

- Continue to develop and reinforce Reading strategies by
 - -Skipping the word then coming back to it.
 - -Stretch the word out then blend the sounds together.
 - -Back up and reread if what I have read does not make sense.
 - -Flip the sound-try another sound the letter/s make.
- Identifying different text types for example simple narratives, instructions and expositions and the language features that help the text serve its.
- Continue to develop children's comprehension by looking at the literal and inferred meaning of a text.

Writing

- Listening for and recording sounds in words.
- Using Capital letters, full stops and spaces between words consistently in their writing.
- Developing editing skills by rereading writing and checking that it makes sense.
- Practising correct letter formations and presenting work clearly and neatly.
- Extending bank of sight words which they can automatically recall in their writing.
- Developing children's understanding of what a syllable is and how it can support their spelling of unknown words.
- Continuing to develop and reinforce knowledge of consonant clusters and digraphs.

Speaking and Listening

- Presenting to the class a 'mini-research project' based on a History focus which interests them.
- Engaging in classroom discussions sharing learning especially during 'Creative Mind Sessions'
- Opportunity to be the 'Star of the Week' and share with the class their life and interests.
- Adding detail when speaking-who, what, why, when and where.

MATHEMATICS

Number and Algebra

• Addition and Subtraction-Explore the connection between addition and subtraction Solve simple addition and subtraction problems using a range of efficient mental and written strategies.

- Multiplication- Recognise and represent multiplication as repeated addition, groups and arrays
- Division-Recognise and represent division as grouping into equal sets and solve simple problems using these representations

Measurement and Geometry

- Time Tell time to the quarter-hour, using the language of 'past' and 'to'
- Name and order months and seasons
- Use a calendar to identify the date and determine the number of days in each month

Number and Algebra

- Describe patterns with numbers and identify missing elements
- Solve problems by using number sentences for addition or subtraction

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

This term will be investigating and developing their understanding about various ways God's people are portrayed in the Old and New Testament. The children will also interpret ways images of God can be lived out in community. They will reflect on encounters with the Word of God and how it is used in the community

CONNECTED LEARNING
