OUR EXISTING PLANNED GIVING RATE IS NOT SUSTAINABLE

Financial projections for the next 3 years based on

Every effort is made to ensure costs are kept to a minimum, but without a substantial increase in income, currently \$40,000pa, we will be unable to fund the ongoing maintenance & operation of God's beautiful Church.
