NEIL AND MAVIS GRUMMITT SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

The Annual Grummitt Scholarship has been generously donated by Neil and Mavis Grummitt and the Awardee will receive a \$5,000 grant to assist with educational costs. Funds may be used over more than one year.

Applicants must be a current student of Kyabram P-12 College.

It is preferred that the Awardee will demonstrate an interest in the field of Agriculture, The Arts (Music) or Teaching. However, special consideration may be given to other academic career aspirations, under the guidance of the Selection Panel.

Applicants will demonstrate a spirit of community within the College, be willing to help others, will be a role model for other students and participate in College and community activities and also represent the College without necessarily being a champion.

The Neil and Mavis Grummitt Scholarship will be awarded to a student of fine character and general all-round ability with a proven financial hardship, who will embrace the culture of a rounded education and who is able to demonstrate that he/she would benefit from the opportunities that such an education would present.

To be eligible, students would be studying Year 11 – 12 in the following year and have proven financial hardship. One or more students may be eligible for full or part of the annual scholarship amount. This will be decided on an annual basis by the Selection Panel.

Students wishing to apply should demonstrate an “exemplary attitude and a desire to learn”.

Selection Panel

The Selection Panel shall consist of:

- College Chaplain
- 7-12 Assistant Principal
- 10-12 Learning Community Leader

After the scholarship closing date applicants will be short listed. After this time, interviews will be held to determine the successful awardee/s.

Recommendation will then be made to the College Principal of the successful candidate.

Funding Use

Monies may be approved to be spent on the following:

- Textbooks
- School Uniform
- Camps and excursions
- Living expenses
- ICT Technology for example, ipad, laptop
- College Materials and Resource costs
- Instrumental Music
- Tutoring
- Other - as approved by the College Principal, Chaplain, Assistant Principal, Business Manager.

Please Note: If the entire Scholarship amount is not utilised while the student remains at the College, they may retain the remaining funds to help with further education 'and/or living' expenses.

Reporting Requirements

The Awardee shall be required to meet and report annually to the Grummitt family on areas of interest including their academic progress and other relevant matters of interest.

Financial Acquittal

All funds will be held by Kyabram P-12 College.

Dispersal of funds, acquittal and financial reporting to the Grummitt family will be the responsibility of the Business Manager. Reporting will occur in September each year.
