"Pills, powders and liquids": Everything parents should know about ecstasy, 'ice' and other illicit drugs in 2018.

Although alcohol continues to be the most popular and problematic drug used by Australian secondary school students it is the use of illicit drugs such as ecstasy and methamphetamine (ice') that many are most concerned about. Whereas alcohol may have been their drug of choice when they were younger, many parents have little understanding of a range of newer drugs, particularly those liked to the nightclub scene. This presentation will provide information on some of these substances, including prevalence rates amongst secondary school students, harms associated with their use and the changes we are seeing in how these drugs are being accessed by young people.

Paul Dillon - Director of Drug and Alcohol Research Training Australia (DARTA) presented at the College in 2015 and due to a positive response we have invited him back to the College to speak with the parents of both Kilbreda and St Bede's College students in Years 10, 11, & 12.
