Week 1-5 2025: Newsletter

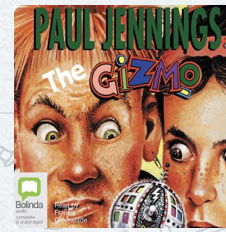
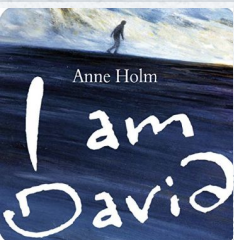

READING



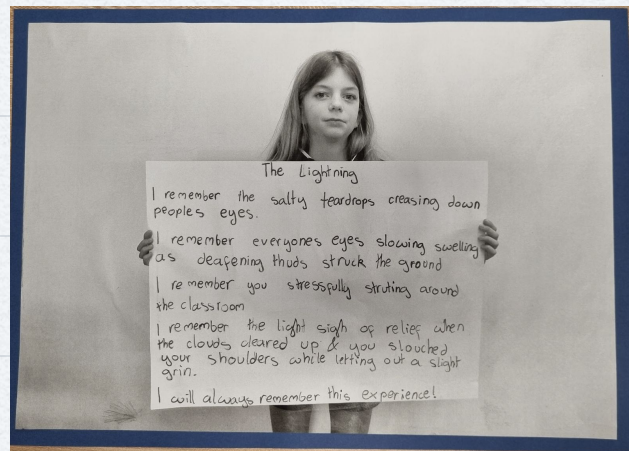
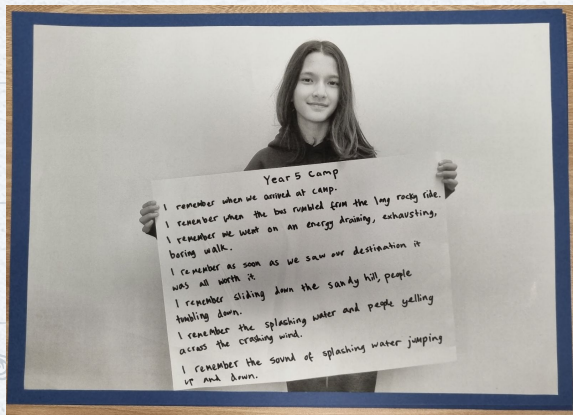
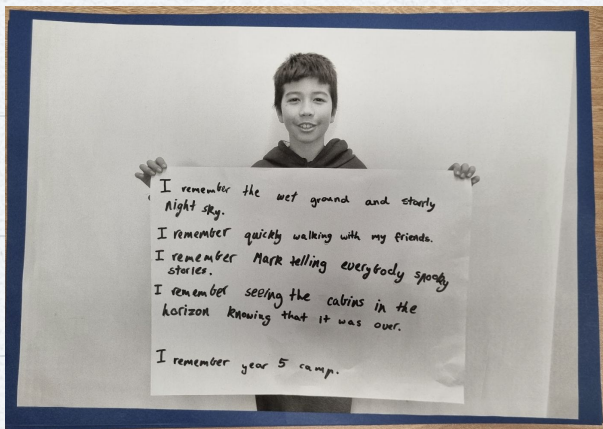

WRITING

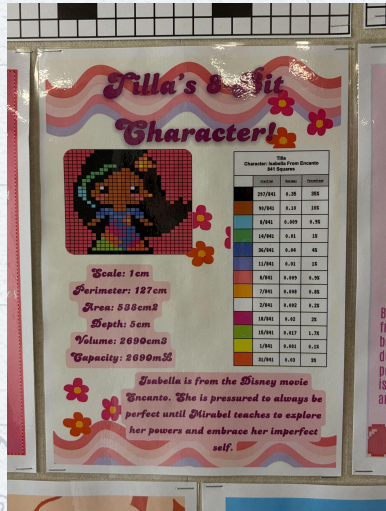

MATHS

In Maths, students consolidated their understanding of measurement (area, perimeter, and volume) and fractions (including decimals and percentages) through our engaging 8-Bit World project.



As part of this learning cycle, students researched the history of 8-bit computing and designed their own unique character. The following measurement lessons were based on their creations, culminating in a detailed poster that showcased all of the mathematical concepts they had learned.

Sabrina: Hey, I' ve just the most fun idea ever! What if we went to PARIS!

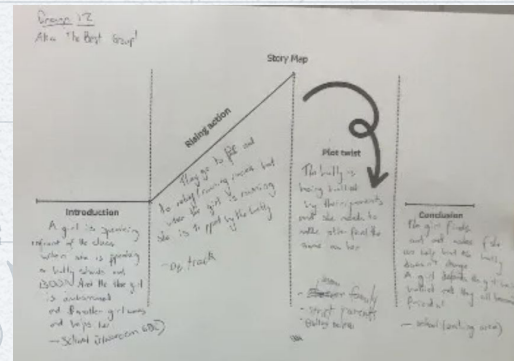
Taylor's face lights up with joy.
