Every team is only as good as the sum of the player selected and the potential a player possesses cannot be measured. Selectors look for not only individual talent but for a fine blend of skill, fitness and competiveness and individuals who will blend well as a team and are capable of achieving their goals.

What selectors are looking for:

- Good footwork and change of direction
- Acceleration and change of direction
- High work rate
- Balance and control without the ball
- Balance and control with the ball
- Speed, agility, endurance and elevation

• Athletic ability, body control and coordination

Ball Skills

- Good basic ball handling skills under pressure
- Good pass selection options under pressure
- Selection of ball delivery finesse and touch
- Accuracy of pass
- Catching ability two hands / one hand

Attacking Skills

- Ability to make appropriate decisions
- Effective use of space
- Timing
- Vision

Defending Skills

- Good one on one defending
- Defence of pass

Strategies

• Recognize and adapts to attacking / defensive strategy changes by opposition.

- Court craft ability to read the game
- Flair and creativity
