Dear parents,

The Grade 10 Camp is a great opportunity for students to spend time together, participate in team activities, grow as a cohort, receive spiritual input and develop relationships. The Grade 10 Camp will be at Camp Clayton in Turners Beach near Devonport.

Travel

The bus will **depart** from the main carpark (outside the hall) at 7.00 am on Tuesday 16 February. Students will need to arrive at school no later than 6.30 am to allow time to pack gear and arrange bus seating. Please help to ensure that your son or daughter arrives on time and is ready to go.

Students are permitted to be in free dress.

Students will require a packed morning tea and lunch for the first day. A water bottle is also recommended.

The return bus on Friday 19 February will be arriving back at the College by 4pm. Families will be notified if there is any delay in the expected return time. A packed lunch will be provided by camp for students on the final day.

Payment Arrangements

The cost of the camp has been advertised through the College Newsletter and is \$280. The cost of the camp will be invoiced to families as part of school fees.

Medication & Diet

If your son or daughter requires prescription medicines whilst on camp, please arrange for these to be safely stored by staff. The medications should be sent in the original container displaying the instructions as provided by the pharmacist or in regulated dosage containers. Staff will have the medical forms of all students and medicines must be passed to a supervising staff member on the morning of departure.

The camp kitchen needs as much prior notification as possible to cater for special diets. All special dietary information must be included on this form.

Form Return – Friday 5 February (end of Week 1, Term 1, 2021)

Please ensure that all fully completed forms are returned **to the school office as soon as possible**, and no later than **Friday 5 February**, especially if you are providing special dietary requests.
