Background

The Royal Commission into Family Violence identified the role that schools have in creating a culture of respect to change the story of family violence for future generations.

In 2016, respectful relationships education became a core component of the Victorian Curriculum from Prep to Year 12, and is being taught in all government and Catholic schools and many independent schools.

In 2017, the Department began implementing the Respectful Relationships initiative, with provides schools with strategies and tools to implement a whole-of-school approach to Respectful Relationships education.

ACIL Allen Consulting has been engaged by the Department of Education and Training to evaluate the Respectful Relationships initiative.
