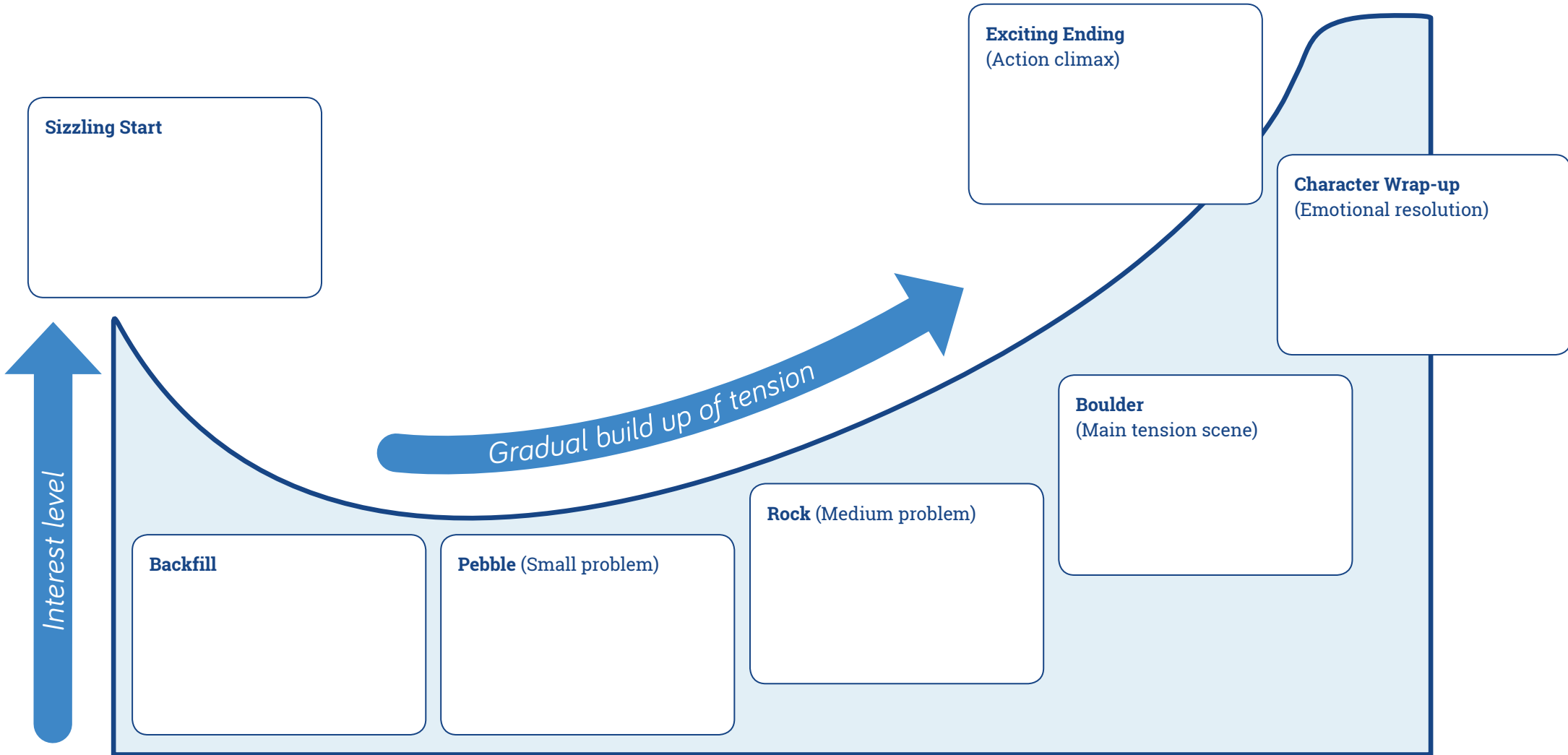
PLOT YOUR STORY ON THE
