Composition and the Art of Collage

with our ARTIST IN RESIDENCE - KIM PRICE

Fundamentals of collage, cut and create with mixed media artmaking

Term 1 / 2026/ Fridays / 2.30—4.15 / 7 weeks

In this program, students will explore collage as a fine art form. They will learn core techniques—cutting, gluing, selecting images and papers—and the foundations of strong composition. Students will experiment with using collage to convey narrative and emotion through intentional placement of elements. Each week students create a variety of collage artworks covering surrealism, landscapes, and figurative work. The program also introduces the geli plate to produce unique collage papers as well as tips to combine collage with materials such as paint, pencils and pastels.

Kim Price is a mixed media and collage artist based in The Gap, Brisbane. Over more than ten years of practice, she has exhibited widely, including her first solo show at Land Street Gallery in 2023 and the 2024 group exhibition Collage Encounters: Our World in Layers. Kim has completed multiple collage and mixed media courses and has been a finalist in several Queensland and interstate art prizes, including FACETS (Toowoomba), Cut and Composed (West End Artspace, Melbourne), and Fifty Squared (Brunswick Street Gallery, Melbourne). She is an active member of her local art community and regularly exhibits across Australia.
