Population: The Population of Egypt in 2020 is 102,334,404 people

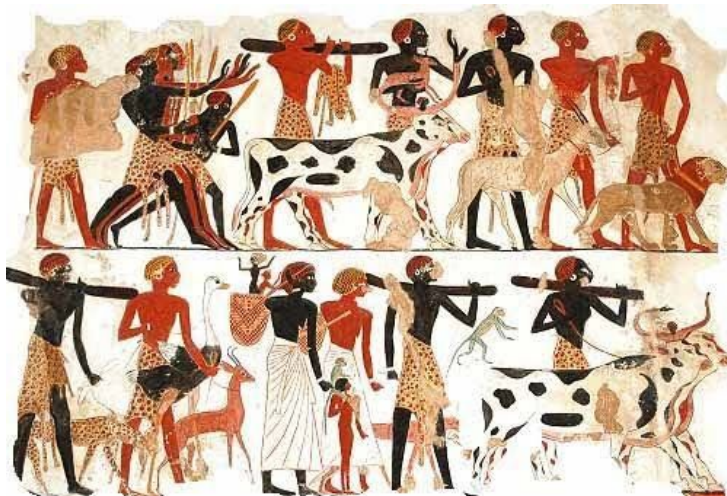
Capital City: The Capital of Egypt is Cairo
