The [Bachelor of Biomedicine](#) -

- Contributes to the evolving health sector with a highly specialised major in cancer, immunology, physiology, or biochemistry.
- Trains students in high-tech labs and through interactive and authentic activities that prepare you for real-world situations.
- Develops strong foundational knowledge in topics such as biochemistry, molecular and cell biology, human physiology, infectious and non-communicable disease.
- Assists students in gaining a pathway into high-demand postgraduate degrees in research, medicine, physiotherapy, and more.

The Bachelor of Biomedicine was recently revised and offers four unique and industry-focused majors that offer students strong employment opportunities upon graduation, and the potential to pathway into further postgraduate studies.

➤ **The ANU Vice-Chancellor Scholars Program**

The Australian National University (ANU) may offer a number of awards known as the ANU Vice-Chancellor Scholars Program.

The objective of the award is to improve access, participation, retention and successful completion for domestic students from under-represented backgrounds by reducing financial barriers to studying at ANU. The award aims to support students experiencing educational disadvantage and to promote a diverse and inclusive student cohort, and recipients will receive this award for up to four years.

➤ **Pathway Diplomas**

When students commence a Pathway Diploma, they become part of the ANU community. They learn alongside Bachelor students attending the same classes, meet people who share their ambitions and experience all that student life has to offer.

Upon successfully completing a diploma and meeting the GPA requirements, students can progress into a second year of an aligned Bachelor program with one year of credit – meaning students can complete their Bachelor's degree within three years of starting a diploma. ANU currently has three diplomas commencing in 2027 that align to 11 Bachelor degrees.

VCE Science Exam Revision Events

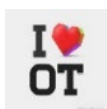
Monash Science is excited to support students currently studying a range of VCE subjects through on-campus revision lectures in the upcoming September school holidays.

Note: The University of Melbourne does not offer courses in Occupational Therapy; however, it does offer an exciting post-graduate course in the [Master of Clinical Rehabilitation](#), which is aimed at upskilling qualified allied health professionals, including physiotherapists, occupational therapists, exercise scientists, nurses, and medical doctors. To be considered for entry into this course, applicants must have:

- an undergraduate degree in the discipline of physiotherapy, medicine, exercise science, occupational therapy or nursing; and
- at least two years of relevant post-entry to practice professional work experience.

Graduates of the [Bachelor of Exercise and Sport Science \(Majoring in Exercise Science\)](#) will be well-prepared for the Master of Physiotherapy.

Note: **Monash University** offers the [Doctor of Physiotherapy](#) and the entry requirements are a completed relevant bachelor degree which must include studies in human anatomy **AND** human physiology **AND** biostatistics.

Note: **University of Melbourne** offers the [Doctor of Physiotherapy](#) and the entry requirements are any bachelor's degree and completion of prerequisite subjects in both human anatomy **AND** human physiology (or equivalent).
