Lenten Penance Obligations

- All who have completed their 18th year and have not yet begun their 60th year are bound to **fast and abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.**
- All who have completed their 14th year are bound to **abstain from meat** on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
- Pastors, teachers, parent are to ensure that even those who, by reason of their age, are not bound by the law of fasting and abstinence from meat, are taught the true meaning of penance.

PASCHAL PRECEPT: Each of the faithful is obliged to receive Holy Communion at least once a year, between Ash Wednesday(26 Feb 2020) and Trinity Sunday (7 June 2020).

All faithful are obliged to confess their grave sins at least once a year

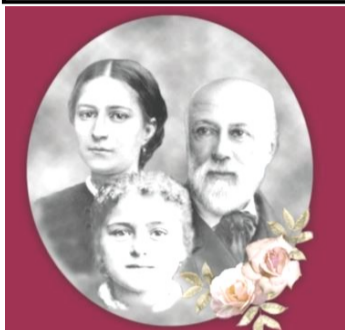

Little Flower changed the World - St Therese of Lisieux 1873-1897

The relics of St Therese and her parents Sts Louis and Zeile have begun their 100 day journey in Australia. During World Youth Day, 1997 in Paris, Pope St John Paul II declared St Therese a Doctor of the Church- the only Doctor of his pontificate- in tribute to the powerful way her spirituality has influenced people all over the world. Therese Martin was the last born of nine children to Louis and Zeile Martin on the 2 January 1873 in Alencon, France. She



joined the Carmelite convent and her book , *The Story of a Soul*, is a classic of spiritual theology.

"My mission to make God loved - will begin after my death," she said.

"I will spend my heaven doing good on earth. I will let fall a shower of roses." Roses have been described and experienced as Saint Therese's signature. Countless millions have been touched by her intercession and imitate her "little way". She has been acclaimed "the greatest saint of modern times.", through simple loving service. She died at 24years of age in 1897 from Tuberculosis.

Gospel Reading: A reading from the holy Gospel according to Matthew

Jesus said to his disciples: 'You have learnt how it was said: Eye for an eye and tooth for tooth. But I say this to you: offer the wicked man no resistance. On the contrary, if anyone hits you on the right cheek, offer him the other as well; if a man takes you to law and would have your tunic, let him have your cloak as well. And if anyone orders you to go one mile, go two miles with him. Give to anyone who asks, and if anyone wants to borrow, do not turn away.

'You have learnt how it was said: You must love your neighbour and hate your enemy. But I say this to you: love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you; in this way you will be sons of your Father in heaven, for he causes his sun to rise on bad men as well as good, and his rain to fall on honest and dishonest men alike. For if you love those who love you, what right do you have to claim any credit? Even the tax collectors do as much, do they not? And if you save your greetings for your brothers, are you doing anything exceptional? Even the pagans do as much, do they not? You must therefore be perfect just as your heavenly Father is perfect.'
