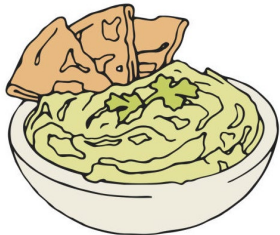
6. Australia's men's cricket team will experience a 66-day gap between home games this year, due to overseas commitments. How many **FULL** 7-day weeks are there in 66 days?



7. To feed a 3-month old puppy costs \$1.80 per day. How much does that work out at per full 7-day week?



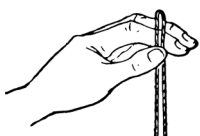
