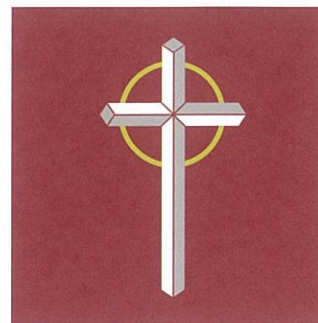


ST JOHN the EVANGELIST PARISH
