

MERIT SCHOLARSHIPS FOR 2025



Agribusiness Australia Scholarship

Valued at \$3,500 and awarded to a current Year 12 student intending on studying an agriculture degree or a degree where they intend to establish a career in agriculture.

Applications are open and will close on 22 August 2024 at 5:00pm.

AgriFutures Horizon Scholarship

The AgriFutures Horizon Scholarship is awarded to CSP students studying an **agriculture-related undergraduate degree** or a Science, Technology, Engineering, Maths/Finance (STEM) degree with relevant majors which align to agriculture.

In partnership with industry sponsors, the AgriFutures Horizon Scholarship is an initiative supporting students enrolled in full time study at an Australian university by providing:

- A bursary of \$5000 per year for the final two years of your degree
- Professional development workshops
- Annual industry work placements aligned with the scholar's areas of interest and their sponsor's industry
- Opportunities to network and gain knowledge at a range of industry events.

To be eligible, students should be considering studying a degree related to agriculture, such as:

- Agricultural Science
- Rural Science
- Livestock/Animal Science
- Veterinary Science
- Agribusiness
- Plant Science

- Agricultural Economics
- Resource Management
- Sustainability
- Food Security
- Agricultural Economics
- STEM aligned with agriculture

Scholarship recipients will be selected on the basis of their commitment to a career in agriculture, as well as their leadership potential and high school academic record. To be eligible for the AgriFutures Horizon Scholarship, students must be enrolled full-time in their **last two years** of an agriculture-related undergraduate degree at an Australian university.

APPEA Oil & Gas Industry Engineering Scholarship

The Tony Noon Scholarship is open to all Australian residents who are already undertaking a degree, with an aim to one-day work in the **petroleum industry**. Current Year 12 students are encouraged to flag this scholarship and apply in the August of the year relevant to them. Applicants must be enrolled in Honours, Masters, or PhD programs at an Australian university and may come from a range of disciplines, including, for example, geology, safety, engineering, economics, law, or environmental management. The scholarship is a once-off grant of \$3,000.

Australian Awards – Scholarships for International Students

The Australian Government provides development awards and scholarships to international students from developing countries.

These scholarships are offered for the minimum period necessary for the individual to complete the academic program specified by the university or TAFE institution.

Australian Catholic University

Range of scholarships valued between \$1,500 and \$20,000, including equity scholarships, some once-off payments and others per year. Some of these include -

Catherine McAuley Scholarship (pending)

Valued at up to \$10,000 and on offer to a CSP student applying to study **any undergraduate degree** within the Faculty of Health Sciences, Education and Arts or Law and Business at the <u>Brisbane Campus</u>. An <u>online application</u> is required, and applicants will be assessed based on the strength of the following criteria:

- Written statement
- Evidence of contribution to community service or leadership
- Letter of Recommendation

Global Excellence Scholarship for International Students

Valued at up to \$20,000 and on offer to International students commencing business and information technology courses. No application is required; all eligible students applying to study business, or IT will automatically be considered.

ACU International Student Scholarship (pending)

Valued at a 50% tuition reduction for the duration of the course, and on offer to International students who have demonstrated outstanding academic merit in prior studies. Applicants must have already received their University offer to be eligible to apply.

George Alexander Foundation Scholarships (pending)

Valued at \$24,000 and on offer to CSP students applying for **any undergraduate degree** at the <u>Ballarat</u>, <u>Blacktown</u>, <u>North Sydney or Strathfield Campuses</u>. A minimum ATAR of 75.00 is required, and students will also be assessed based on the strength of the following criteria when making an <u>online application</u>:

- Written statement
- Values statement
- Academic merit
- Leadership and community participation
- Resume
- Letters of recommendation

* Ramsay Scholarship (pending)

Established in 2020, this scholarship supports commencing CSP students who attain an ATAR of 92.00+ and enrol full-time in the <u>Bachelor of Arts (Western Civilisation)</u> **OR** the <u>Bachelor of Arts (Western Civilisation)/Bachelor of Laws</u> **OR** the <u>Bachelor of Arts (Western Civilisation)/Master of Teaching (Secondary)</u> at the <u>North Sydney Campus</u>. Valued between \$90,000 and \$160,000 and will be paid in instalments each semester. <u>Online applications</u> for the Ramsay Scholarship for 2024 will open in August. Visit Ramsay Scholarship.

Thomas More Law School Academic Excellence Scholarship (pending)

This scholarship reflects ACU's commitment to academic excellence in any undergraduate **law and/or criminology and criminal justice degree** and is valued at \$10,000 and on offer to eligible CSP students. <u>Online applications</u> are assessed based on the strength of the following criteria:

- Academic merit (based on ACU GPA)
- Written statement
- Letters of recommendation
- Interview

Australian Institute of Quality Surveyors

AIQS offers a number of scholarships each year for Year 12 students who qualify for entry into a Quantity Surveying, Construction Economics, Construction Management (Economics) or other appropriate course at an AIQS accredited university in Australia. **Applications are open and close 31 October 2024.**

Australian National University

Range of scholarships each year, each ranging between \$1,000 and \$20,000, some once-off payments and others per year. Some of these include -

National University Scholarship

Awarded to eligible CSP students who have achieved an ATAR of 99.90 and above, **across all faculties**. No application is required. All eligible applicants who have put in an application to ANU will be automatically considered. Applicants who have put at least one ANU program as a first, second or third preference when applying for admission through the Universities Admissions Centre (NSW & ACT) will also be considered. Scholarship valued at \$12,500 per year, for a maximum of five years.

❖ ANU Chancellor's International Scholarship

Awardees receive a tuition deduction of between 25% and 50% (fee waiver), and these scholarships are awarded to eligible International students who receive an offer to commence **any eligible undergraduate degree** in 2025 (except Doctor Of Medicine and Surgery (MChD)). There are various categories of these scholarships, and no separate application is required as applicants are automatically considered based on them meeting the eligibility criteria.

College of Engineering, Computing & Cybernetics Excellence Scholarship for Women

Valued at \$5,000 per year over two years, and on offer to CSP female students who have applied an undergraduate program offered by the ANU College of **Engineering & Computer Science**. All eligible applicants who have put in an application to ANU will be automatically considered.

ANU Science Olympiad Scholarship

Valued at \$5,000 per annum over three years, and on offer to CSP <u>and</u> International students who have represented Australia and been awarded a Gold Medal in the International Science Olympiad in one of the following areas - Biology, Chemistry, Earth Science, Geography, Mathematics or Physics. Eligible students must attain a minimum ATAR of 95.00, and apply to enroll in a course offered by the ANU College of Science or the ANU College of Health and Medicine. An <u>online application</u> is required for this scholarship. Applications are open and will close 30 November 2024.

❖ Dean's International Science Excellence Scholarship

Valued at \$5,000 over one year, and open to International students applying to **study science at the ANU**. An <u>online application</u> is required for this scholarship and eligible students will be provided a link to apply.

* Research School of Finance, Actuarial Studies & Statistics Bachelor of Finance, Economics & Statistics (Honours) Scholarship

Awarded to CSP <u>and</u> International students with a minimum ATAR of 99.00 and entering the **Bachelor of Finance, Economics, and Statistics (Honours)**. All eligible applicants who have put in an application to ANU will be automatically considered. Scholarship valued at \$10,000 – paid in two instalments over one year.

Australian Veterans' Children Assistance Trust

Open to CSP students, AVCAT Scholarships, including the Long Tan Bursary, are for the children and grandchildren of Australian ex-serving veterans. Scholarships are provided from \$4000 to \$6000 per year, for three years, to full-time students at university, TAFE, or a registered training organisation.

BeMo[®] Diversity Advocacy Scholarship

BeMo to offer bi-yearly \$10,000 scholarships to **Pre-medical and Medical Students**. Only students currently applying for undergraduate medicine are eligible to apply for this scholarship. All applicants must **record and submit** a short video (1 to 5 min) and share it to their social media pages as per the instructions indicated in the link below no later than the scholarship deadline of 31 October 2024.

Bond University

Bond University offers an extensive scholarship program, with values ranging from 25% scholarships to 100% scholarships. The scholarships listed below are open to both local and onshore International students. Some of these include -

Vice-Chancellor's Elite Scholarship

This 100% scholarship is available to all Year 12 students with an ATAR above 95.00: with exceptional academic achievement, proven leadership ability and personal character, and extensive involvement in extra-curricular activities. Open to all undergraduate degrees excluding the Bond Medical Program. Applications are open and close 1 August 2024.

Excellence Scholarship

Awarded to eligible Year 12 students with an ATAR of over 92.00, demonstrating high academic achievement, as well as leadership skills and community involvement. Excellence Scholarships cover up to 50% tuition for any single or approved combined undergraduate degree (excluding the Bond Medical Program).

Victoria Student Bursary

Awarded to eligible Year 12 Victorian students who are interested in pursuing their passions and enhancing their educational experience at Bond University. Successful candidates will be provided with a cash award of \$5,000.

Judge John Newton Mooting Scholarships

Valued at a 50% tuition remission, Judge John Newton Mooting Scholarships are awarded exclusively to a Year 12 students who have participated in the Bond University National High School Mooting Competition. In addition, students must demonstrate high academic achievements, as well as demonstrated record of leadership, initiative and service to their School and/or Community. Students are expected to attain an ATAR of 92.00 and intend studying the Bachelor of Laws or an approved combined program that contains a Bachelor of Laws.

Leadership Scholarship

The Bond University Leadership Scholarship aims to recognise current Year 12 students who have demonstrated high academic achievement, as well as outstanding leadership skills and community achievements, with a 25% tuition remission scholarship, for **any single or approved combined undergraduate degree** (excluding the Bond Medical Program). Students who are predicted to achieve an ATAR above 84.00 are eligible to apply.

Transformer Scholarship

The <u>Transformer</u> is a co-curricular program offering at Bond designed to enable students to innovatively tackle real-world problems that matter. It is a program that attracts motivated, self-directed individuals who want to work in collaborative, interdisciplinary teams on challenging projects that typically span multiple semesters. Transformer Scholarships are awarded annually to students beginning their Bachelor's degree or

Master's degree study at Bond University in the following year, January semester. Transformer Scholarships offer up to 50% tuition remission for **any single undergraduate** Bachelor's degree or postgraduate Master's degree program (excluding the Bond Medical Program) and are awarded to students who have high potential to affect real change through participation in the Transformer program.

CoLab Industry Scholarships

A 25% tuition remission scholarship awarded to eligible students who anticipate attaining an ATAR of 80.00, and wish to study one of the following Transformation Degree programs:

- Bachelor of Entrepreneurial Transformation
- <u>Bachelor of Digital Transformation</u>
- Bachelor of Health Transformation
- <u>Bachelor of Legal Transformation</u>

Besides the <u>Vice-Chancellor's Elite Scholarship</u> and all sports scholarships which close on 1 August 2024, applications for most other scholarships close on 29 August 2024. Charles Allan Seymour Hawker Scholarship

Valued at \$60,000 over three years, and open to Australian citizens, the C.A.S. Hawker Scholarship commemorates the achievements of one of Australia's most respected pastoral pioneers who served with distinction in the First World War and went on to

become a distinguished scholar and leading figure in the Federal Parliament prior to his tragic, and untimely death in an aircraft accident in 1938.

The scholarships have been awarded almost equally to male and female applicants. Scholarship holders have come from every sector of Australian society and graduated from government, catholic and private schools. The majority of scholarships are awarded to students entering their first year of university. Past awardees have studied law, politics, economics, medicine, and arts. Hawker Scholars are now working in Australia, Europe, the USA, and Asia.

Applications for the 2025 Hawker Scholarship will open on 18 November 2024 and close on 6 January 2025. * RMHC Charlie Bell Scholarship

The RMHC Charlie Bell Scholarship Program provides financial assistance towards vocational or tertiary studies for students who have experienced serious illness. Children aged 15-20 years who have been treated at a Children's Hospital for serious illness or injury are eligible to apply for a one-off grant of \$5,000 to undertake a course of instruction in accredited undergraduate institutions to make a huge difference in their life. Charles Sturt University

Unless specified, scholarships at Charles Sturt University range in value between \$2,000 to \$6,000, and some are a once-off payment and others per year. Some of these include –

Vice-Chancellor International Scholarship

Valued at a 50% tuition fee reduction, and open to eligible International students applying to enrol in a wide range of - <u>courses</u> (not the Bachelor of Dental Science and Bachelor of Veterinary Science). This scholarship is for outstanding students who demonstrate Charles Sturt values and community contributions. Eligible students will be invited to apply, and applications close 15 November 2024.

International Student Merit Scholarship

Valued at 25% tuition fee reduction, and open to International students. This scholarship recognises and rewards excellence for eligible students applying to study at Charles Sturt University. There is no separate application as application for this scholarship will be automatically considered by the admissions team when students apply for an eligible course on an eligible campus.

Casella Family Brands Health Scholarship

Valued at \$10,000 and paid over two instalments in one year: open to CSP <u>and</u> International students applying for study at the <u>Wagga Wagga Campus</u> of CSU. Commencing students to have an ATAR score of 65.00 or above. An <u>online application</u> is required for this scholarship. The eligible courses are –

- Bachelor of Medical Radiation Science (with specialisations)
- Bachelor of Health Science (Mental Health)
- Bachelor of Nursing

* Rural Australia Foundation Scholarship (pending)

Valued at a one-off \$5,000 and available to eligible CSP and International students commencing a Bachelor of Agriculture OR Bachelor of Agricultural Science OR Bachelor of Agricultural Business Management OR Bachelor of Horticulture at the Wagga Wagga campus. Students who attain an ATAR of 65.00 and above will be eligible to be considered. An online application is required for this scholarship and evidence of community/regional involvement will also be required.

Dr. Peter Hodgson Scholarship (pending)

Any first year CSP <u>and</u> International student studying **any course** at the <u>Bathurst Campus</u> and who attained an ATAR of 85.00 or above is eligible to apply. This scholarship is valued at \$5,000 and is a one-off payment. An <u>online application</u> is required for this scholarship.

Dr Ron Camplin Scholarship OAM (pending)

Open to CSP <u>and</u> International students applying for **any course** at the <u>Bathurst Campus</u> and who attained an ATAR of 85.00 or above. The scholarship is valued at \$18,000, to be paid in \$3,000 instalments twice per year over three years. Second and ongoing payments pending continued enrolment and a GPA of 5.0 or above is achieved. Applicants are required to submit a minimum 250-word essay on "Who is Ron Camplin?", and provide evidence of *sound academic achievement, community/regional involvement,* and *career goals and aspirations.*

Commonwealth Teaching Scholarships

Commonwealth Teaching Scholarships deliver on Action 2 under the <u>National Teacher</u> <u>Workforce Action Plan</u> to help attract high quality candidates into the teaching profession and to help address teacher workforce shortages.

Commonwealth Teaching Scholarships support new undergraduate and postgraduate teaching students to meet the costs of their study in exchange for teaching in government schools or government-run early learning settings for a period of time after graduating from their degree.

Scholarships of up to \$40,000 per student are available for full-time undergraduate initial teacher education (ITE) students (\$10,000 per year for a four-year qualification) and up to \$20,000 for full-time postgraduate ITE students (\$10,000 per year for a two-year-qualification).

Applications are strongly encouraged from school leavers and career changers who meet the eligibility criteria and who are high-achieving students (with an ATAR of 80 or above or equivalent academic result), First Nations peoples, people for whom English is an additional language or dialect, people with disability, people from regional, rural or remote locations, mid-career professionals or people from low socio-economic backgrounds, who aspire to a rewarding career in teaching.

Scholarships will be available over five rounds from 2024 to 2028 with up to 1,000 scholarships per year to be offered. Applications for 2025 will open later 2024/early 2025.

Curtin University

Various scholarships are on offer, and of various values. Some of these include -

❖ John Curtin Scholarship Program

Academically gifted students who display John Curtin's qualities of vision, leadership and community service are eligible to be nominated for the John Curtin Scholarship Program.

There are two scholarships within the Program:

- 1. John Curtin Undergraduate Scholarship
- 2. Julia Gillard Women in Leadership Scholarship

Open to CSP students in the top 5% of their cohort and and be nominated by a professional educator, example school principal. Applicants must be able to demonstrate leadership qualities and engagement in community service. Valued at the cost of the degree plus \$2,000 per annum to assist with living expenses. A one-off \$6,000 cash payment will be given towards an eligible international study experience, and recipients will also have leadership opportunities and mentoring as additional benefits of the scholarships. Applications close 11 September 2024.

Global Curtin Scholarships - Australian Year 12 Scholarship

This scholarship provides eligible International students with 25% off their first-year tuition fee, up to a maximum of 200 credits when enrolling in courses in one of the following faculties:

- Faculty of Business and Law
- Faculty of Health Sciences
- Faculty of Humanities
- Faculty of Science & Engineering
 - Science courses
 - Engineering courses
 - Western Australian School of Mines (WASM)

All students who apply to study at Curtin are automatically assessed for the Curtin International Year 12 Scholarship. No separate scholarship application is required.

Vice-Chancellor's Academic Excellence Scholarship

Valued at \$35,000 to \$80,000, depending on the course duration, this scholarship is awarded by the Vice-Chancellor to Australian undergraduate students whose exceptional academic achievements, proven experience and leadership has truly set them apart. CSP students who either attain an ATAR of 95.00+ OR are the dux of their school, are eligible.

The scholarship includes:

- 100% of Tuition fees
- 100% of Student Services and Amenities Fees
- a cash payment of \$5000 per year
- participation in the <u>Vice-Chancellor's Professional Excellence Program</u>

An <u>online application</u> is required for this scholarship.

Deakin Scholarship for Excellence

This scholarship rewards strong academic performance teamed with excellence in extracurricular activities, community service, elite sport performance, or leadership, or attain an ATAR of at least 85.00.

This CSP scholarship includes \$5000 paid as cash or towards tuition fees per year, or towards student contributions (tuition fees) – the student may choose.

An <u>online application</u> is required for this scholarship.

Vice-Chancellor's International Scholarship

Awarded to International students and provides 50% - 100% towards tuition fees, as well as participation in the <u>Vice-Chancellor's Professional Excellence Program</u>, and priority place in on-campus accommodation (at own cost and subject to availability). An <u>online application</u> is required for this scholarship.

<u>Note</u>: Unsuccessful applicants of the Deakin Vice-Chancellor's International Scholarship will automatically be considered for the Deakin International Scholarship.

Deakin International Scholarship

To be eligible, must be a commencing International student applying to enrol in a Deakin University undergraduate course. Successful students will receive 25% towards tuition fees. An <u>online application</u> is required for this scholarship.

Deakin STEM Scholarship for International Students

International students (citizens from Cambodia, China, Hong Kong, Indonesia, Kenya, Malaysia, Nigeria, Pakistan, Philippines, Sri Lanka or Vietnam), and applying to study undergraduate courses in the disciplines of architecture and built environment, engineering, information technology, data science and analytics, science or environment are encouraged to apply for the Deakin Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) Scholarship. Recipients will receive a 20% reduction in tuition fees. Academic eligibility for VTAC International students is 5 points above the published

lowest selection rank ATAR. No separate application is required, and all eligible students will automatically be considered.

❖ IGNITED Scholarship

The IGNITED Scholarship has been created to ignite women's interest in industry areas traditionally dominated by men, including engineering, information technology and construction management.

This scholarship is open to female CSP students who attain an ATAR of 70.00+ and are entering an approved undergraduate course.

If successful, students will receive a minimum of \$5,000 per year plus an academic mentor. An <u>online application</u> is required for this scholarship. Applications expected to open early-September 2024 and will close early January 2025.

Defence STEM Cadetships

Open to Australian students, the Defence STEM Cadetship Program offers cadets a head-start in their careers. Cadets can play a part in keeping Australia safe and secure while completing their tertiary studies. The Program is an entry-level employment pathway for high-performing undergraduate students currently studying for a relevant STEM degree. Defence also provides some financial support for a cadet's tertiary studies, including reimbursement of university course fees (upon successful completion of the relevant STEM units each semester in the program) and a bursary payment of \$3,000 per Cadetship year.

Current Year 12 students are eligible to apply after having completed 12 months of their bachelor's degree, and achieved a credit average ($GPA \ge 5$ on a 7-point scale).

Department of Defence Science and Technology

The Defence Women in STEM Undergraduate Scholarships are aimed at encouraging high-performing women to continue their university study in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) fields and improve the representation of women in the STEM workforce. These scholarships are sponsored by the Defence Science and Technology Group (DSTG), the Australian Government's lead agency responsible for applying science and technology to safeguard Australia and its national interests. Eligible students must be an Australian citizen **commencing a STEM degree** at an undergraduate level.

- Demonstrated or potential leadership skills
- Extra-curricular activities (sporting, cultural activities, volunteer/work experiences)
- Aptitude and commitment to studies

An online application is required. Applications are open and close 30 September 2024. By applying for this scholarship, students may automatically be considered for a few others.

Applications close for many merit scholarships on 30 September 2024. Numerous faculty scholarships are not listed above, and students are encouraged to visit and browse <u>UNSW Scholarships</u>.

University of Queensland

UQ's undergraduate scholarship program is one of the largest in Queensland and one of the most generous in Australia. Valued between \$6,000 and \$30,000. Some of these include –

UQ Academic Scholarships Program

UQ's Academic Scholarship program aims to reward the achievements of outstanding CSP <u>and</u> International students. There are two scholarships on offer and only one application needs to be made and students will be considered for both.

1. UQ Vice Chancellor's Scholarships

Valued at \$12,000 per year for up to 5 years, these scholarships will be awarded to CSP and International students who achieve an ATAR of 99.90 and apply through QTAC for a UQ course and list it as a first preference. Students must provide evidence of their most outstanding achievements from Years 11 and 12 in the areas of leadership and community service. Students must submit an online application to be considered. Applications open in early August 2024 and close in November 2024.

2. <u>UQ Excellence Scholarships</u>

Valued at \$6,000 per year for up to 4 years, these scholarships will be awarded to CSP <u>and</u> International students who attain an ATAR of 99.00 and who, during their senior years, have demonstrated outstanding extra-curricular academic and/or leadership and/or significant community service achievements. Students must apply through QTAC for a UQ course, and list it as their first preference. Students must submit an <u>online</u> <u>application</u> to be considered. Applications open in early August 2024 and close in November 2024.

Applicants only need to complete and submit ONE application form to be considered for the two Academic Scholarships listed above. Applications open early August 2024 and details on how to apply can be found at UQ's Academic Scholarships Program.

Liveris Academy Undergraduate Scholarship

Valued at \$10,000 per annum for the minimum completion time of the course, and open to CSP <u>and</u> International students applying to study in the **Computer science and IT**, **Engineering, Science and Mathematics** areas. Successful candidates may also receive up to \$10,000 for travel support for an approved Gap Semester, exchange or internship opportunity. An <u>online application</u> is required, and applications open soon, and close in early August 2024.

UQ Ramsay Undergraduate Scholarship

Valued at \$32,000 per year for up to 5 years and intended for academic CSP high achievers who desire to make a difference in the world. They are for students who are creative and intellectually curious with the critical skills to challenge the status quo and cross boundaries, and who value discussion, debate, and the opportunity to learn from others. The purpose of the scholarship is to support students undertaking a sequence of study in **Western Civilisation** either through the Bachelor of **Advanced Humanities**

(Honours) program or the dual Bachelor of Humanities/Bachelor of Laws (Honours) program. An <u>online application</u> is required, and the closing date is 4 August 2024.

UQ International Excellence Scholarship (pending)

Valued at 25% reduction in tuition fees per semester for up to four years, and open to International students who attain an ATAR of 99.00 and are applying for an eligible course. No separate application is required as students who meet the eligibility criteria will automatically be considered.

International High Achievers Scholarship – Global (pending)

Valued at 20% tuition fee reduction per semester, and open to International students. All eligible applicants will be considered automatically for this scholarship if they meet the eligibility criteria and have received an offer for a course.

International Onshore Merit Scholarship (pending)

Valued at \$5,000 tuition fee reduction per semester for the first two semesters (A\$10,000 in total), and open to International students who have achieved a competitive ATAR and received an offer to study full-time at UQ commencing Semester 1 or 2, 2025 in an eligible program. All eligible applicants will be considered automatically for this scholarship if they meet the eligibility criteria and have received an offer for a course.

Vice-Chancellor International Scholarships Scheme

The Vice-Chancellor's International Scholarship scheme is open to all International students with an offer to study at the University of Sydney. No application is required, as all eligible students who have secured an unconditional offer of admission will be automatically considered.

Co-operative programs are awarded to students with a good academic record, demonstrated leadership potential, and a genuine interest in IT. Students need to meet the prerequisite subjects, expect to attain an ATAR of 85.00 - 99.00+, and submit the online UTS BIT application form no later than 8 September 2024.

Women in Engineering and IT Cooperative Scholarship

Valued at \$66,000 and 3 internships throughout the degree, and open to CSP female students who attain an ATAR of 85.00+ and intend enrolling in the <u>Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) Diploma in Professional Engineering Practice</u>. The scholarship will include three (3) industry placements as well as mentoring, networking, leadership, and professional development opportunities. All candidates must apply using the UTS <u>online Scholarships Application</u> form to be eligible for consideration. Applications close on 8 September 2024.

WA Women's Society of Fine Arts and Crafts Scholarship

omen of STEM Scholarships

Valued at \$5,000 annually for the duration of the degree, and offered to young Australian women aged 17-20 who are studying a degree in a STEM related field –

- SCIENCE: Biology, Chemistry, Geology, Physics, and Environmental Science
- **TECHNOLOGY**: Computer Science, Information Technology, and Software Disciplines
- ENGINEERING: Electrical, Electronic, Mechanical, Civil and Robotic Engineering
- MATHEMATICS: Applied Mathematics, Statistics, Data Analytics

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide the chosen applicants with financial aid to be used for general living expenses, course expenses, textbooks, extracurricular or any additional education. The recipient must be actively enrolled and studying during the duration of the scholarship.

The awarded scholarship will amount to \$5,000 per year and will continue to be paid each year the recipient continues to study provided they maintain a credit average. This time period is dependent on the student's degree length however it will not exceed more than four years. The amount will be paid fortnightly.

An <u>online application</u> is required, and applicants will be invited for an interview.

THE INFORMATION PROVIDED IN THIS RESOURCE IS A GUIDELINE FOR STUDENTS

It is a summary of many of the foremost <u>academic merit</u> scholarships on offer and it is important that students confirm specific details of the various scholarships, i.e., eligibility, and the closing dates for their application/s themselves.

Students should also check whether the scholarships they are applying for are <u>deferrable</u> or not.

It is also advantageous to visit the university websites regularly as they are frequently updated, and detail numerous other scholarships - access & equity scholarships, sport, and accommodation scholarships - not referred to in this resource.

Students should also note that not every tertiary institution is listed here. It is imperative that students are methodical in researching the websites of the institutions they are applying to themselves.

Where possible, reference has been made as to whether the scholarship is available to Commonwealth Supported Students (CSP) – referring to Australian citizens, some New Zealand citizens, and residents on Permanent Humanitarian Visas only – or whether it is open to International students too.

Students should double-check their eligibility themselves.

Students are encouraged to browse the following links regarding numerous other scholarships - many of which are access & equity scholarships and/or financial assistance opportunities –
