Emotional

Explore the concepts of forgiveness and empathy towards others.

Social

Numeracy

Identify outcomes of familiar events involving chance (Year I)

Describe chance using everyday language e.g. will happen, won't happen, might happen (Year 1)

Identify practical activities and everyday events involving chance (Year 2)

Describe outcomes as 'likely' or 'unlikely' (Year 2)

Identify some events as 'certain' or 'impossible' (Year 2)

Religion

Explain various ways God's people are portrayed in the Old and New Testament.

Explain key scripture stories of Jesus' forgiveness and compassion in terms of impact on community relationships.
