Spending time crafting an artwork out of items that would otherwise end up being thrown away could be a fun project to do at home. The trashy artworks will be shared with the school community in the last week of Term 3.

## Materials:

Artwork should be made from **used, recycled, secondhand or found objects**, such as paper, plastics, cardboard, fabric and old toys. Tape, glue, string and paint can be used to secure and decorate the artwork.

## Who:

Artwork can be created by students independently or with family members.

## When:

A photograph of your artwork is to be uploaded by 5pm on **Friday September 18.**
