

The P.F.A are hosting our annual school disco.

\$2 Entry fee will apply to each student.

Glow items will be available to purchase between \$2 and \$3 each.

Drinks, lollies and chips will be available to purchase from \$1.

Conditions of Entry

- 1. To ensure the safety of all students, parents will only be permitted access to the school gymnasium to collect their children at the end of each session.
- 2. Students will not be allowed to leave the Gym without an adult please DO NOT ask your child to meet you outside, or send in another child to get them.
 - 3. Students will only be permitted access to the disco appropriate to their class level.
 - 4. Only current Oatlands students will be permitted entry to the discos.
- 5. It is recommended that students do not bring valuable items, including Ipads and phones, to the discos. We take no responsibility for lost property. Please label all belongings.
 - 6.It is suggested your child bring the entry fee plus a maximum of \$30. Please explain to your child the difference between the entry fee and their spending money.

Please have the \$2 entry fee in hand for quicker and easier entry.

- 7.A regular parent helper from each prep class has volunteered for the junior disco so all preps will have a familiar parent to go to if need be.
- 8.If your child has any special requirements for the night please discuss with their class teacher.

9.At the conclusion of each disco parents are to enter the gym through the side door (closest to the Kinder) and exit with their child/ren through the main doors Please collect all belongings.

- 10. No parent cars are to enter the teacher's car park on the night.

 Moving cars and children don't mix.
 - 11. No Outside Food or drink permitted in the disco.

If it happens to be raining on the night, we will try and get the students in as quickly as possible but it may be best to bring an umbrella for when you are waiting.
