Hints for having a successful conference with your child

- ✓ Your child leads the discussion
- ✓ Express pride in growth and progress
- ✓ Acknowledge effort
- Ask questions
- ✓ Be positive
- Listen and respond to the student
- Try not to interrupt. If your child gets stuck, his/her teacher will help him/her to move forward
- Use guiding questions when needed (provided by his/her teacher)
